About Adirondack Quad-County DEC Grants and How to Apply

The New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA) State and Local Partnership Division administers an annual regrant program that helps ensure access to the arts and culture in each of the 62 counties of New York State. In the counties of Clinton, Essex, Franklin, and Hamilton, this regrant is administered by the Adirondack Lakes Center for the Arts (ALCA) in Blue Mountain Lake. Adirondack Quad-County Decentralization Grants are available for not-for-profit and cultural organizations, as well as to individual teaching artists partnering with public schools or other cultural entities for the purpose of arts education, in the four counties served.

For prospective applicants, the process typically begins by attending one of several grant-writing seminars offered throughout the region in late summer/early autumn, in which application assistance is provided. It is a requirement of the grant to attend one of these seminars. The seminars are free and open to the public and announced on the Arts Center website and through emails and the local media.

Guidelines and applications will be available on the website (adirondackarts.org), and the deadline is usually in early autumn. Because of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the application process for 2021 is being pushed back to help ensure that as many organizations and artists as possible have the opportunity to apply. Decentralization Grants are made possible through the New York State Council on the Arts with the support of Governor Andrew M. Cuomo and the New York State Legislature.

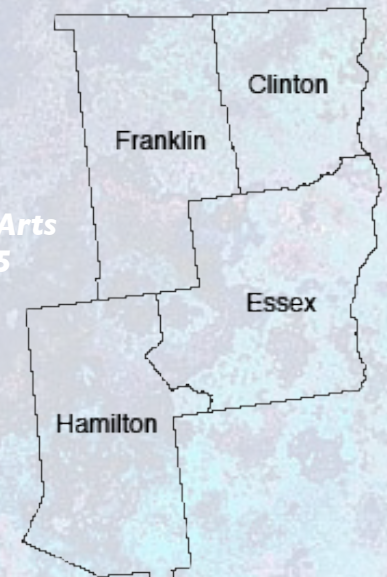
