

## Technical Assistance for ADK Quad-County 2024 Statewide Community Regrants (SCR) Community Arts, Arts Education and Individual Artist Grants

FREE "how-to-apply" seminars and individual consultations with the grant coordinator for arts and cultural organization representatives, teaching artists, artist-collective members, and individual artists seeking support to create art are being offered by the Adirondack Lakes Center for the Arts (ALCA) for proposed arts projects in Clinton, Essex, Franklin, and Hamilton counties. Seminars and consultations will cover the Statewide Community Regrants (SCR) Arts Education, Community Arts, and Individual Artist grants for projects occurring through 12/31/24.

Attendance at a seminar or individual consultation is required of all new applicants and those who did not apply for 2021 Decentralization (DEC) or 2022 or 2023 SCR funding. For arts organizations and collectives and individual artists, including teaching artists, who did apply in either of those years, attendance is optional.

In-person seminars will be held mainly on certain Monday and Wednesday afternoons and evenings and Saturday mornings and afternoons and posted in the "Grant-Application 'How-to' Seminars" section at <a href="mailto:adirondackarts.org/current-scr-grant-cycle">adirondackarts.org/current-scr-grant-cycle</a> as they are confirmed. Seminars held virtually and individual phone consultations, which can be scheduled immediately for sessions beginning January 2nd, will be held mainly on Tuesdays, Thursdays, & Fridays and scheduled around the initial requests of prospective applicants. \*

Advance registration via email is required—the earlier, the better, but no later than 24 hours before the requested time; seminars that have no one signed up by 24 hours before the scheduled start will be postponed to another day and time or canceled outright (seminars must have a minimum of one advance-registrant to take place).
