

## ADK Quad-County 2022-Cycle Statewide Community Regrants (SCR) Community Arts & Arts Education Grants

FREE "how-to-apply" seminars for arts and cultural organizations, artist collectives, and individual artists, including teaching artists, are being offered by the Adirondack Lakes Center for the Arts (ALCA) for proposed arts projects in Clinton, Essex, Franklin, and Hamilton counties, as scheduled below. Seminars scheduled through 1/29/22 will cover both the SCR (formerly called "Decentralization" or "DEC") Arts Education and Community Arts grants for projects occurring between 3/1 & 12/31/22.

Seminar attendance is required of all SCR applicants. Because of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, seminars will be held online via Zoom. Advance registration via email (to receive the link) is required—for daytime seminars, by the day before; for evening seminars, by 12 noon that day (seminars must have a minimum of one advance-registrant to take place).
