THANKSGIVING FOR BAPTISM

As water is poured into the baptismal font, we give God thanks and praise for the gift of our baptism.

P: On this day of celebration and thanksgiving, we gather first around the baptismal font to "remember and rejoice" in the words of one of our baptismal hymns. (ELW #454)

We have been baptised by water and the Word in the name of the Father, + the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Let us give thanks for God's gracious and loving gifts we have received in baptism and for the work God has given us to do in this world:

C: For God's gift of merciful love and grace in Christ Jesus;

For God's gift of the Spirit who leads, guides, teaches and comforts us;

For God's gift of new and abundant life now and in the life to come;

For God's gift of faith by which we learn to trust God;

For God's gift of family of every time and every place;

For God's gift of our calling to work for justice and peace through loving, compassionate service to all people.

P: Let us pray: Loving and gracious God, by the power of your Spirit let these gifts which you have poured out upon us overflow in us and into the lives of our neighbours far and near. May our lives be a blessing in your name to all people; through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

In remembrance of our baptism, water may be sprinkled over everyone gathered as a baptismal hymn is sung, such as:

If this remembrance of baptism is used, the presider says these words after the sprinkling is completed:

- L: God of creation, all you have made is good. Our planet home is showing the burden of human-made climate change. From severe droughts and heat waves to flooding and rising sea levels, from a decline of Artic seaice and retreating glaciers to ocean warming, from desertification and land degradation to pressure on fresh water supplies, from changing ecosystems to economic migration, earth is suffering. We give thanks for the work of CLWR in providing life-saving food assistance, rehabilitating water sources and working with local communities to learn how best to serve them in their own settings.

- L: God of the nations, prophetic voices of old spoke truth to power. Fill the hearts of world leaders and all who govern with such a sense of your justice that their striving for power and dominance is transformed into decision-making that meets the needs of your people worldwide. We give thanks for the work of CLWR as it continues to respond to global crises

as it did at its inception 75 years ago and to address injustices that cause human suffering and poverty.

God of steadfast love and faithfulness... Hear our prayer.

L: God of the orphan, widow and stranger, Mary, Joseph and Jesus fled persecution, seeking safety in a foreign land and still your people flee their homelands seeking shelter and peace. We give thanks for the work of CLWR, resettlement teams, and sponsoring communities of faith who go above and beyond what is required to welcome and embrace refugees and help them start new lives in Canada.

L: God of the marginalized, your Son never turned away anyone who came to him in their need but responded with compassion and healing. We give thanks for the work of CLWR amongst the world's peoples, irrespective of religious beliefs, race, colour, or gender, and its provision of educational opportunities in which students can thrive and vocational training for women which leads to self-sufficiency and economic security.

GREAT THANKSGIVING

P: All creation praises you, O God.

Your glory is displayed from the ocean depths to the vast reaches of infinite space.

All living things make known your wondrous life-giving power.

There is nothing so small but that you care for it.

Truly you are to be given praise with thanksgiving.

Yet, to this day, your human creatures have shown distain for your gift of life, marring the harmonious goodness of our planet home and the network of relationships you have established.

Nevertheless, your merciful forgiveness for wayward humanity, given through your Son Jesus who, on the cross, revealed to us the immensity of your life-giving love, is steadfast and prodigal.

P: We remember that in the night in which he was betrayed, our Lord Jesus Christ took bread, and when he had given thanks, he broke it, gave it to his disciples and said, "This is my body which is given for you. Do this in remembrance of me."

In the same way also he took the cup, after supper, and gave it to his disciples, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood. Do this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me."

- P: As often as we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes:
- C: Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.

P: We give thanks for the life renewed in us through the death, resurrection and ascension of your Son.

We pray for the invigorating power of the Spirit that presses us onward in faith to be justice-makers and peace-bearers, that everyone may know the abundant life you desire for all creation

All praise be to you, gracious God, through Christ our Lord, by the power of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.
