On Saturday, August 14, 2021, starting at 8:30 am, Haiti suffered an earthquake with a magnitude of 7.2.

The entire country felt the earthquake, which was followed by several aftershocks. The south region has been the most affected, particularly the towns of Jérémie and Les Cayes (Haiti's important 3rd city).

Collapses of homes, churches, hospitals, and other public services have caused deep unrest and hardship for the people of Haiti.

### Your impact has been immediate

Thanks to your support, our partners in Haiti have delivered medical assistance to those affected and in need. Searches under the rubble are continuing, and basic necessities have been delivered to displaced families.

Work will continue towards rehabilitating affected homes to help facilitate a return of the families, but for now we are providing shelter to protect them during this rainy season.

There is a need for drinking water in some places because the water supply structures have been affected, and educational institutions which suffered the effects of the earthquake will also need to be re-established. This will be made possible by the generous, collective support from people like you. Thank you.
