BACKGROUND

Many families in Ukraine have been struggling, far from home and trying their best to provide for their children under stressful and difficult circumstances. Due to the ongoing conflict, public services have been under extreme pressure. and the needs of displaced people and their host communities have shifted. The safety, dignity, and mental health of vulnerable people. including those with disabilities, women, children, and the elderly, are of key concern.
