DONATION IMPACT REPORT

CLWR is responding to the Ukraine crisis as part of a coalition of churches and faith-based organizations.

To date, our partners have provided food packages, emergency supplies and medical equipment, and have established Refugee Support Points, Child Friendly Spaces and Transitional Shelters.

The war in Ukraine has caused death and suffering on a dramatic scale and has left millions of people in urgent need of humanitarian assistance.

The conflict has caused the world's fastest growing displacement crisis since World War II, with nearly 13 million people uprooted in less than two months.

Over a quarter of Ukraine's population have fled their homes, including nearly two-thirds of children who have been displaced.

Thanks to your fast and generous response, we are able to help provide families with food packages and other vital supplies.

Lutheran World Federation and our partners in the ACT Alliance are continuing to provide life-saving humanitarian aid, being among the first humanitarian aid organizations to have visited affected areas.

To date, the distribution of food and various core relief items inside Ukraine includes:

- o Lviv – 82 tonnes
- o Zakarpattia – 111 tonnes, plus 10 ventilators
- o Ternopil – 32 tonnes
- o Ivano-Frankivsk – 32 tonnes
- o Chernivtsi – 19 tonnes
- o Bucha – 8 tonnes, plus 10 generators
- o Zaporizhzhia – 11 tonnes
- o Kyiv – 7 tonnes

In addition, 3 tonnes of food and 1.5 tonnes of core relief items (e.g. underwear, diapers, personal care & hygiene products, detergent, dignity kits and masks) were delivered to the border point in Zosin, Poland, for distribution into western Ukraine. So far, 500 families have received food and another 400 have received core relief items.
