

The Same Reward

Partnership is an equally shared harvest.

We started out this last season declaring that it was going to be a "Summer of Miracles" and we have been seeing God move in amazing ways across Canada and in the North! In our last Newsletter we talked about our plans to travel all the way up to Grise Fiord, Canada and North America's most northern civilian community. It was an unprecedented trip for us as a ministry, because it

was the first time in BPEA's history that we had taken the gospel that far north and God did not disappoint! After being delayed a few days because of weather we finally arrived in Grise Fiord, community with a population of 130 people. (We initially understood it was

150 but turns out it's a bit smaller.) Out of the 130 we had 50 people come out to our meeting and 25 of those accepted Jesus for the first time!

We hosted the meeting in a local school gym that had several large bay windows and just as Inuit were responding and praying to receive Jesus, the sun broke through the clouds and flooded in through the windows! It would be a beautiful moment in and of itself, but we later learned that this community

hadn't seen the sun in 3 weeks and those attending were visibly moved by the presence of God in that moment!

Canada is being reached for the Kingdom of God and there is only one community left in Nunavut in our Arctic Hope Tour, Baker Lake!

We're currently scheduled to fly up in early November with a small team and after that trip BPEA will be able to say that because of phenomenal partners like you, we have been able to personally take the gospel and this message of hope to every single Nunavut community!

As we move toward 2020, we really feel the Lord is shifting our focus to begin building and developing Inuit youth as church leaders in their communities. Together we saw over 700 salvations in the last 18 months and now feel it is our responsibility to individually disciple small groups of these young people to do the same work of the Kingdom in the communities they come from. We're currently working with churches here in the South who have a desire to adopt individual Nunavut communities and to begin developing relationships with the pastors as they look for ways to pour into them as a local church. We are seeing young people catch the purpose of God for their lives and because of

partners like you, we are committed to raising and building a whole new generation of young people who are passionately serving God!

1 Samuel 30 tells the story of David and his men setting out to fight a battle against the Amalekites, and while there were 400 men who set out to fight alongside David, another 200 stayed behind with the supplies. After David and his men returned from a victorious battle with all the plunder, an argument broke out among the men about whether those who stayed behind should receive the same reward as those who fought. In verse 24 David replies and says, "The share of the man who stayed with the supplies is to be the same as that of him who went down to the battle. All will share alike." This is the same principle that God uses when we partner financially with those He has called to a mission field that we may never see. In His eyes, both the sower and the reaper are rewarded the same; the victory is shared equally among them.
