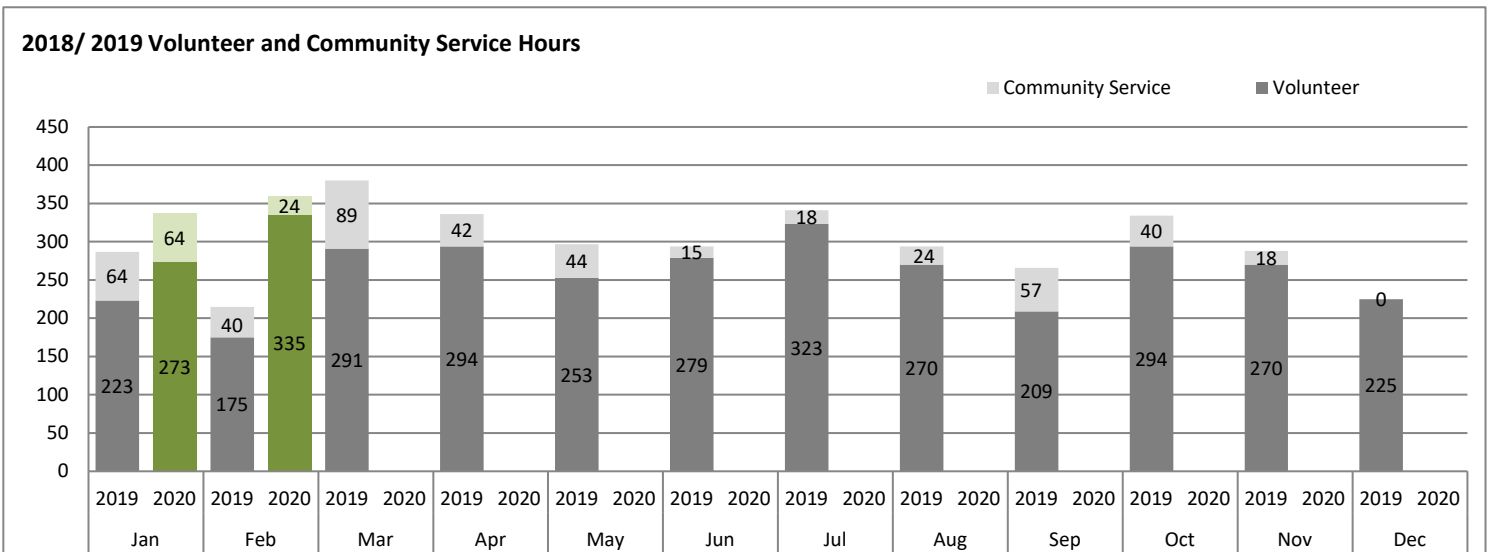
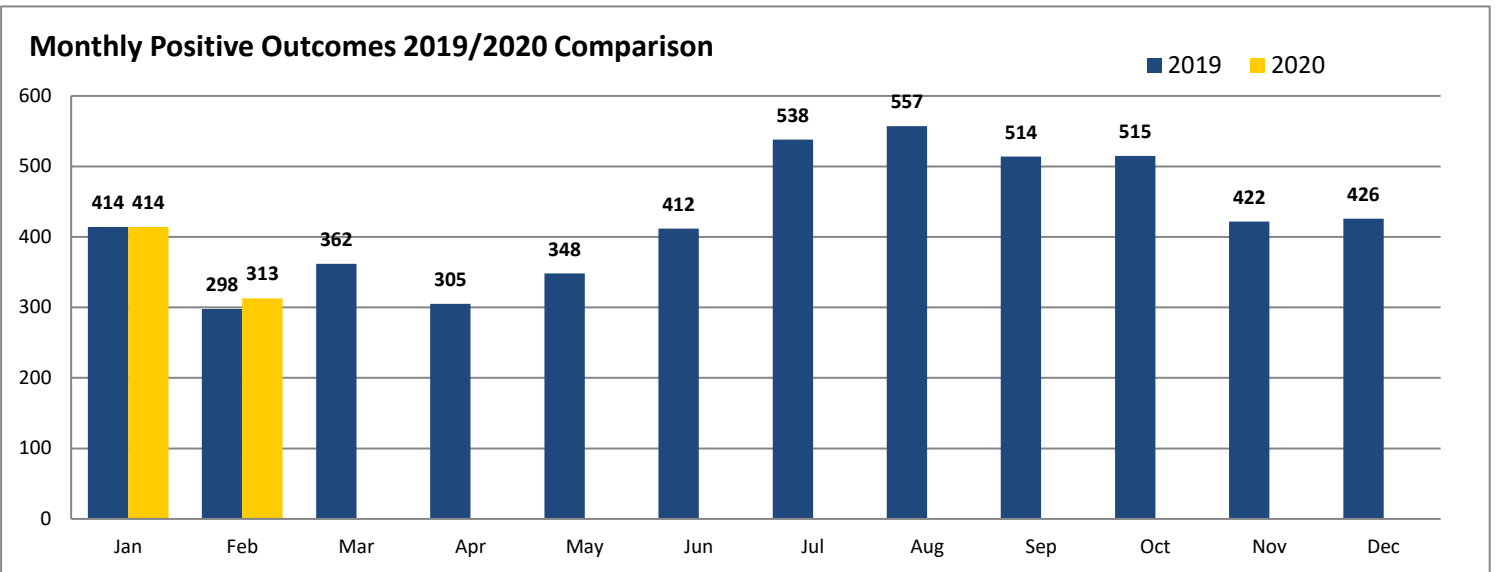
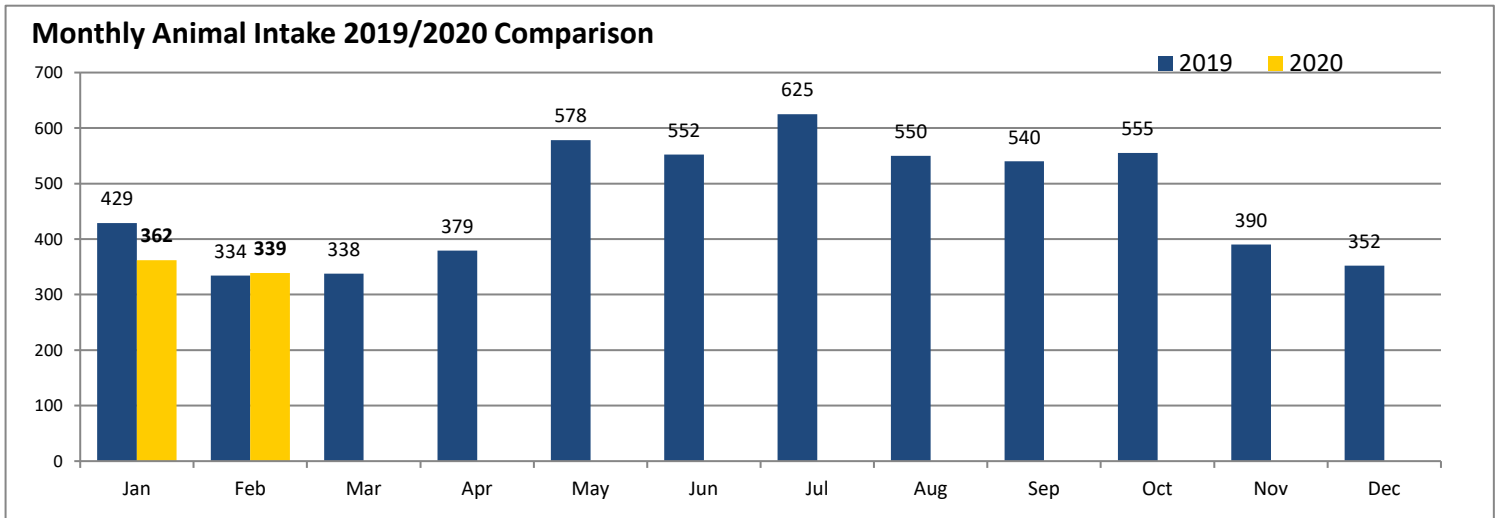
Shelter Euthanasia Reasons

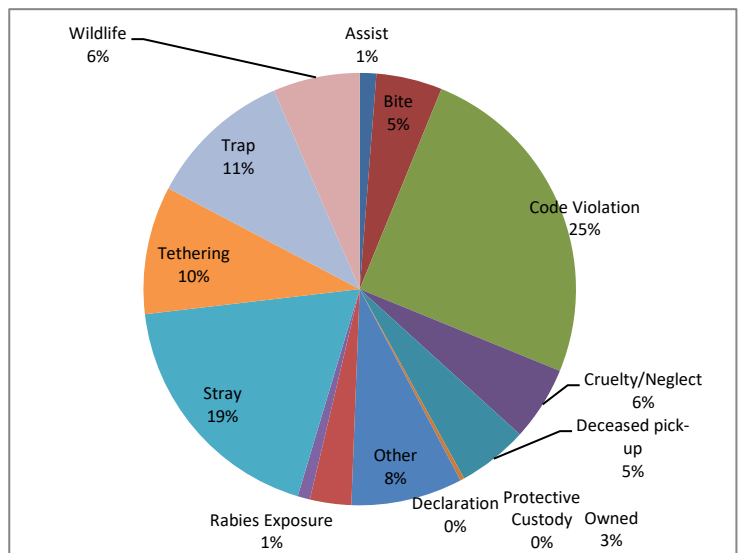
