



27th Annual Art at the Crossroads

General Information

We would like to invite you to show your artwork at the 27th Annual Art at the Crossroads Regional art exhibit. Crossroads welcomes all media types for this Judged Show. Artwork will be accepted one week prior to or on Tuesday, September 2, 2025. **We will be closed September 1st.** The show will open on Friday, September 5, 2025. Monetary prizes and awards will be presented at the judge's discretion. A People's Choice award will be selected by the community and patrons who attend the opening reception and cast their vote before 8:00pm.

ENTRY CRITERIA & RULES

- Open to professional and amateur artists aged 18 years and up.
- Each artist may submit a total of 3 entries that have not been previously shown at a Crossroads open show.
- Entry fee per artist: \$30 for members/\$35 for non-members
- All items must be available for sale: there is a 30% commission for Crossroads member artists and a 40% commission for non-members.
- Paintings must be dry and appropriately presented, mounted, or framed, ready to hang with D-rings and wire attached. No saw tooth hangers accepted. 3-D work must be clean and ready to display.
- Work submitted must be of original design, and not violate copyright laws to the best of the artist's knowledge.
- Work that is manufactured, imported, reproductions made from kits or under the supervision of an instructor will not be eligible.
- If artwork is over 50 lbs. or over 40x40", please make arrangements with gallery two weeks prior to intake day. Please contact angela@crossroads-arts.org to make arrangements.
- The gallery committee reserves the right to refuse any artwork which is inconsistent with general quality of the exhibit.
- If there are more entries than space allows, it may be necessary to limit the number of entries per artist.
- All artwork will be handled with reasonable care.

JUDGE: CASSANDRA SCHIFFLER



Cassandra Schiffler is a painter, printmaker, and arts administrator from Boise, Idaho. She has followed her passion for the arts throughout her personal and professional life, exhibiting her artwork in solo and group exhibitions throughout the US while maintaining various professional jobs in the arts such as working in galleries, museums, print studios, universities, art appraisals, and city government. She currently serves the arts community in her role as President on the Board of Directors for Surel's Place, an artist-in-residence nonprofit organization in Garden City, and as the Arts & Culture Coordinator for the City of Meridian where she manages Meridian's thriving public art program, the Initial Point Gallery, and many other multifaceted arts and culture programming and events. She has been named on the Idaho Business Review's Power List of professionals working in the Arts, and in 2024, she received an Accomplished Under 40 award. 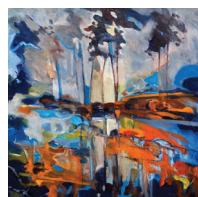
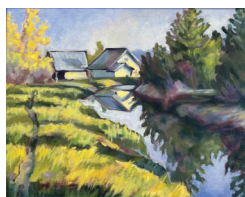
