- Paintings must be dry and appropriately presented, mounted or frame, ready to hang with D-rings and wire attached.
- Work submitted must be of original design, of high quality, and to the best of artists' knowledge does not violate any copyright laws.
- All items must be available for sale. Artist receives a commission of 65%.
- If artwork is over 50lbs. or over 40" x 40" please plan arrangements with Angela Blair.
- The Gallery Committee reserves the right to refuse any artwork which is inconsistent with the general quality of the exhibit. If there are more entries than space allows, it may be necessary to limit the number of works per artist. All artwork will be handled with care.
