- Accepting artwork on Monday, July 29 and Tuesday, July 30, 2024 from 10am to 5pm
- We are unable to accept late entries
- First Friday Opens: Friday, August 2, 2024 from 5:30 to 8pm
- Close of Show: Saturday, August 31, 2024
- Pick up unsold artwork: Monday, September 2, 2024

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- "Bountiful Baker" is open to professional and amateur artists aged 18 years and older
- We are accepting up to 3 pieces of artwork from each artist. Size restrictions may apply.
- Entry fee: \$15 for members, \$20 for non-members
- All work must be original. All 3D pieces must be ready to display.
- Works made in an art class and/or under the supervision of an instructor are not eligible.
- Reproductions and works made from kits are not eligible
- All artwork must be for sale
- There is a 30% commission for Crossroads members and a 40% commission for non-members
- The Gallery Committee reserves the right to refuse any artwork which is inconsistent with the general quality of the exhibit. If there are more entries than space allows, it may be necessary to limit the number of works per artist shown. All artwork will be handled with reasonable care.
