

COVID- 19 Disability Accommodations for Face- Coverings

OHA Guidelines for Face Coverings as of 06/12/2020

“If a business chooses to require customers or visitors to wear a face covering, they must:

- *Develop a policy and post clear signs about this requirement. A policy that requires customers and visitors to wear face coverings must:*
- ♣ *Make reasonable modifications to their policy to allow people with disabilities to access their services.*
- ♣ *Consider whether to provide face coverings for customers or visitors who do not have one.”*

Crossroads can make the following reasonable accommodations to people who contact the Executive Director Ginger Savage at 541-523-5369 and request these accommodations.

For Guests of the Art Gallery:

The featured show is on our website each month to enjoy. Or we can provide them with a clear face shield at no charge to wear to the gallery.

Crossroads is providing a special Senior Citizen/Immune Compromised time to view the art show every Thursday from 10 am to Noon. Crossroads is open Monday thru Saturday from 10 am to 5 PM.

For Arts Education Students:

Crossroads will provide to students at no charge a Face Shield. If this student needs to read lips the teacher will be required to wear a face shield.

OR

We are getting a laptop for teachers to use at the art center for Web-EX meetings so that students can receive services from home. Students will need to pay for instruction.

Teachers are being provided the following options:

- To set up the laptop in class so the student at home can engage with their fellow students and the teacher can instruct the whole class.
- If that is too much for our teachers to handle, then they can arrange another time to work with you.
- Another options is that students can send photographs of class work and can be coached by the instructor calling them on the phone
