In March, rains in Kenya caused flooding and devastation. Brian's home was flooded and his family's crops were destroyed. A neighbor took the family in until their house was clear of the flood water. Brian's parents work as laborers on local farms, but fear of Covid-19 has closed farms and resulted in them losing their income. The family has planted new crops on their own land, and Brian's parents will use the crops to feed their family.
