### Micro-Enterprise Grant Program

- 8 grants (6 in India and 2 in Kenya), averaging \$988, were awarded since our last *OneVoice*!

In India, the grants will be used to expand an existing flower business, start a pan shop, create a computer and Xerox shop, open a mobile accessories kiosk, start a ladies tailoring shop, and expand a mess and tiffin service. For those who may not know, a mess and tiffin service serves delectable and home-cooked meals at inexpensive prices.

In Kenya, the awards will help a mother start a small scale dairy farm to support her family and help a young man with a DVD sales business expand into an entertainment and gaming zone.

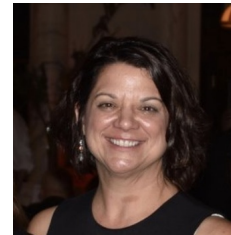

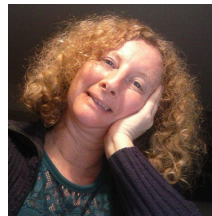
