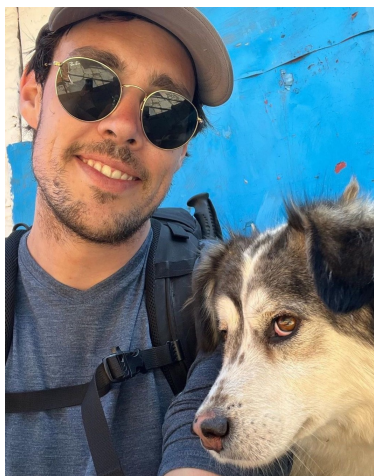

On the first day of training to climb Mont Blanc, Laurent experienced a medical emergency, just 200m after the group's departure to Gran Paradiso. The rest of his climbing group, along with Laurent's family, created this memorial in the place where Laurent lost his life.



Laurent lived an active lifestyle, and was excited and prepared to take on this adventure of Mont Blanc, to advocate for the hemophilia community. We are devastated by this loss and our hearts are with Laurent's family and friends.

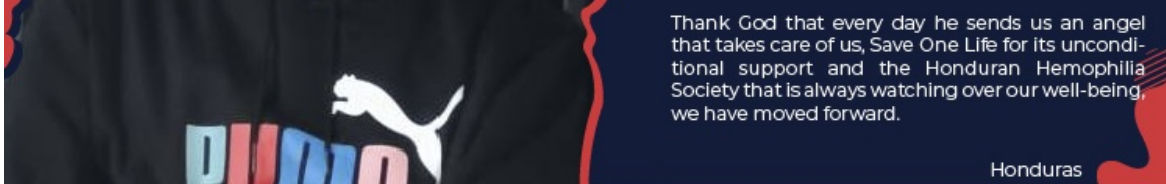
Thank You, from Honduras

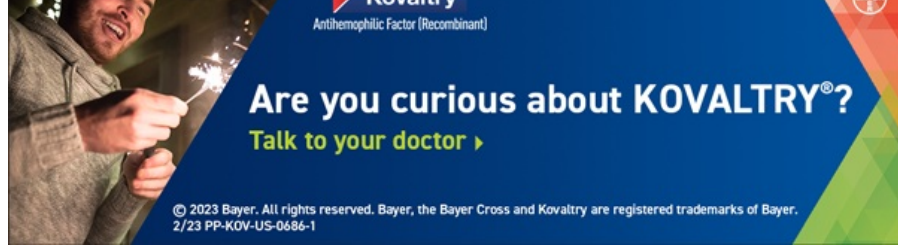
