With her micro-enterprise grant, Rose from Kenya was able to expand her chicken business.

She improved her coop, installed heat lamps, purchased baby chicks and, most importantly, replenished her supply of feed for the coming year. In the past, Rose paid higher prices for smaller amounts of feed. She has now secured a bulk order and can pick up feed as she needs throughout the year.

With the profits from her business, Rose plans on improving her son Derrick's room and paying for his transportation to and from school. Derrick, who has hemophilia and uses crutches, needs private transportation to get to school.
