

See the difference your donation makes!

Save One Life creates annual updates for each child in our sponsorship—including yours. It contains pictures of your child and a message about how your donation helped them the previous year.

We encourage you to read it and hope you enjoy the information contained. Annual updates are involved and touched by many people—in the U.S. *and* overseas.

Here's how it happens:

- Save One Life works with over 50 program partners, mostly run by volunteers.
- Program partners interview *every* family in the sponsorship program (more than 1,400!) to collect information about their home, medical history, education and more *every* year. This ensures your donations are being used appropriately.
- Reports for each child are sent to Jenn Brockway-Peirce, our program manager, beginning in March each year. She reviews each one and creates your annual update.
- In most instances, annual updates are posted in your account by the fall. You'll receive an email when it's posted. We wish we could provide you with updated information about the child you sponsor more frequently, but it is not possible—for us or our volunteer-run program partners.


