In June of 2012, Barry Haarde dipped his front wheel in the Pacific Ocean and spent 50 days riding 3,667 miles through ten states and Canada to make history as the first person with hemophilia to cross the country on a bicycle. While dipping his rear wheel in the Atlantic Ocean at Wallis Sands Beach to culminate his ride, an elated Barry turned to Laurie Kelley and declared, "Let's do this again next year!"

He would go on to ride 16,728 more miles and raise over \$250,000 for Save One Life.
