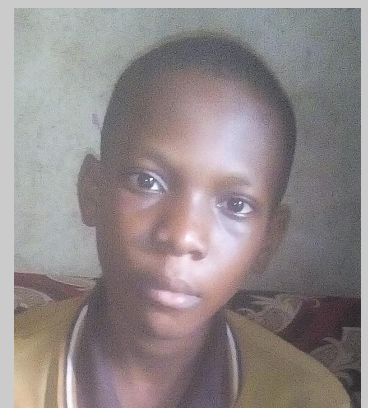

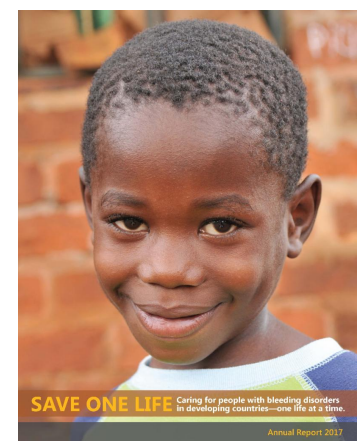

Save One Life president Laurie Kelley will lead a seven-mile bike ride that will start at 3:30pm from Odiome Point to Wallis Sands Beach, where we will dip our bicycle wheels in the ocean in Barry's memory. A shuttle to Wallis Sands will be provided for non-cyclists to share in the memorial wheel dipping.

Once we return to Odiome Point we'll enjoy good food and drink, story-telling and sharing memories we have of Barry and his Wheels for the World rides.

The event will take place under a tent come rain or shine.

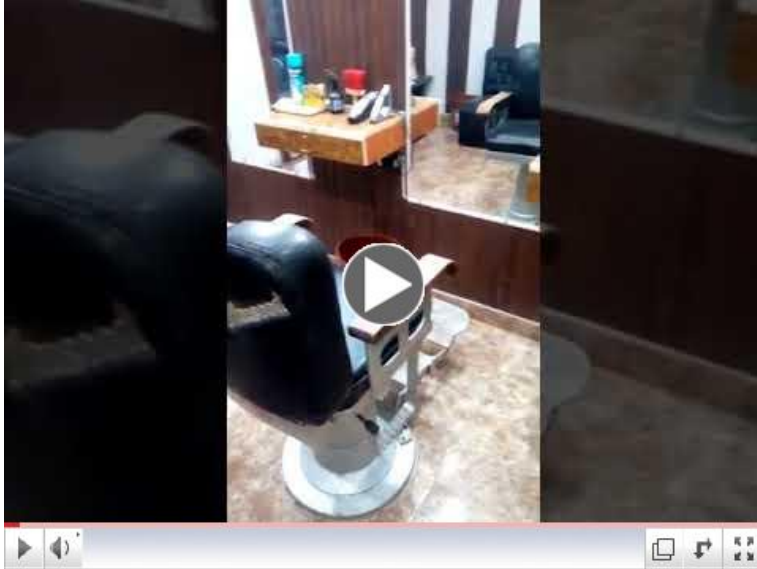
