SECOND ROUND DISTRIBUTION

3350 people are not just statistics, these are lives of people in the slums being touched and being given hope in these uncertain times.

We heard from our friend Zahara who was digging the trash scavenging bread crumbs for her kids. They were going to feed on that expired bread that day and the next day.

Because that was her only way to feed a family of 6.

No parent should have to dig through the trash to find her children something to eat.

Because of your help Zahara has enough food for the next three weeks.




In the midst of continued Lockdown, you've served 137,200 meals to those going hungry.

Families who couldn't afford to feed their families before coronavirus are in an even worse position now. And those who could afford food are no longer able to do so.

Some desperate parents are begging others to take their children to feed them. One family was was feeding on wild weeds for 2 days, they boiled grass risking their lives because some weeds are poisonous to human

We are feeding families. We are on the ground, and we move fast. Each of our food packs can feed a family for a week and they are recieving 3 food tickets for three days

Over 680 families in the slums of Kosovo and Katanga are picking their food packs from our food points with their food tickets.

Your support is also supporting local business like Kanyanko-re's Retail shop. Kanyankole has been our agent for 5 years through feeding programs and this time through the pandemic he turned into a real blessing. He got us a huge deal on the food we were buying and thats why we are able to reach these numbers and families.

He mentioned to us the sales were going down dramatically asn he had stocked food but people werent buying as he expected.

Through this sale his business can make it through this pandemic steadily







Meet Hellen


66 I don't think thank you is enough, They gave us more than food, They gave us Hope. 99

If you watched our first appeal for help during the lockdown you may remember a lady called Hellen, our contact person in the Katanga slum.

Hellen looks after 17 orphans, and we support her with the kids' education and with food. The situation was expected to get serious because the kids are now staying home from school because of COVID. Hellen was struggling after the Us4Women shop she runs in Katanga was closed because of COVID'19 and social distancing. She says this help went beyond having food.

She says it has given them hope to stand tall and strong through these uncertain times. Hellen has enough food to provide for the 17 orphans that she looks after for the next 21 days and she can't thank you enough on behalf of the thousands of people you have helped.

Widows. Orphans. Grandparents. They were going without food, and had no idea when they might have their next meal. They are poor. They are quarantined in their homes by the police because of COVID-19. And they felt utterly abandoned by the world as they are not in their homeland.

These families live day-to-day at the best of times. Those who are able to work, mostly sell groceries. Others are hawkers. This is daily work—they get paid a little each day for their effort, just enough to feed their family that day, if times are good. These families never get the chance to save money, or to stock-up for hard times.

When we heard about these families starving, we asked for your help. You showed up, and donated enough to allow us to deliver food to 14,300 meals of the most vulnerable families in this community. Within a day, the food was purchased from our retailers and ready in shops for pickup —all in a way to protect both families and volunteers from contracting or spreading the deadly virus that is responsible for this community's lockdown.
