**COVID-19 Risk Level**  
**Updated 11/18/2020**

Hope's Senior Leadership Team conducts a weekly review of active cases within the State as reported by DHSS and the trends indicated. Cases for both residents and non-residents are significant as travel into the State of Alaska is not closely managed for quarantine purposes and many exposure events are directly related to travel activities.

Data from November 11, 2020 reports are showing trends that support Hope remaining in high vigilance (Phase I) for assisted living homes, with continued use of a value based risk/benefit discussion tool to develop person-centered mitigation plans to encourage safe outdoor activities, exercise and family visits.
