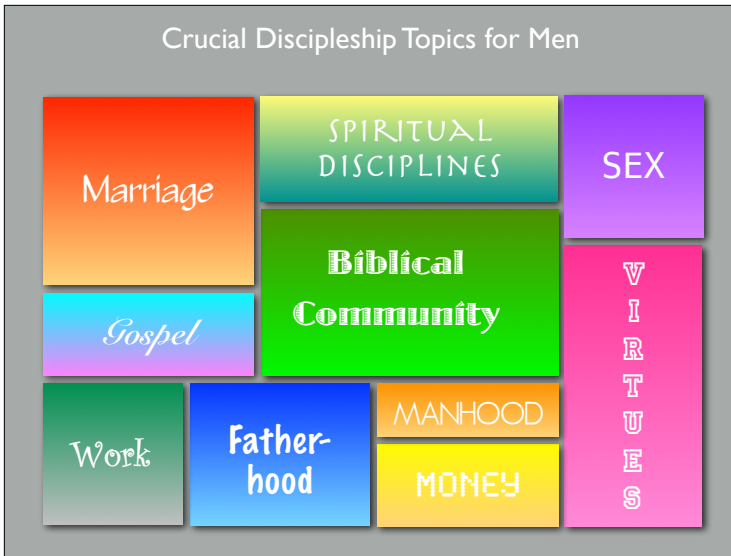


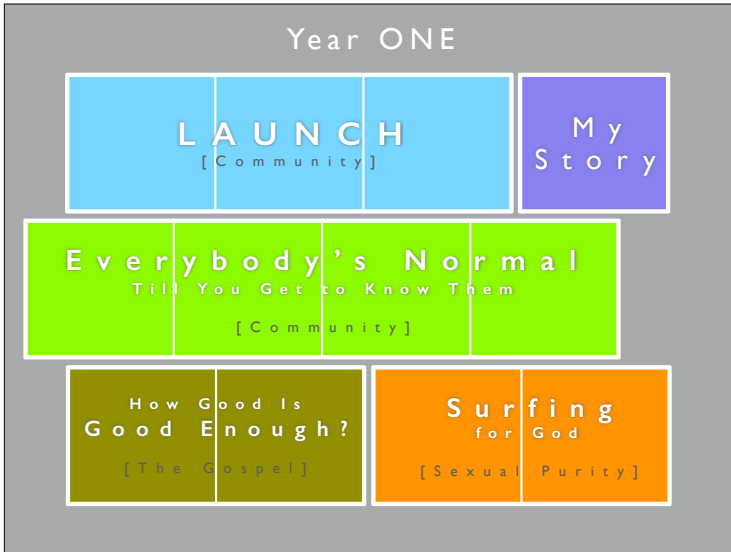
## Crucial Discipleship Topics for Men



Here are some biblical topics that are crucial for men to study and discuss as disciples of Jesus.

- Addressing these “Top Ten” topics in the months and years to come will ensure that the men in your Covenant Group will discover how to knowledgeably and practically follow Christ in all these areas.
- It will also keep your group from drifting aimlessly, wondering what to do next.
- Set your own course or follow the recommended Discipleship Path (see below).
- Of course there are other areas of study you may want to address, but thoughtfully choose core discipleship topics.
- It is also advised that you revisit these topics, going more in-depth or emphasizing different aspects of the topic each time.

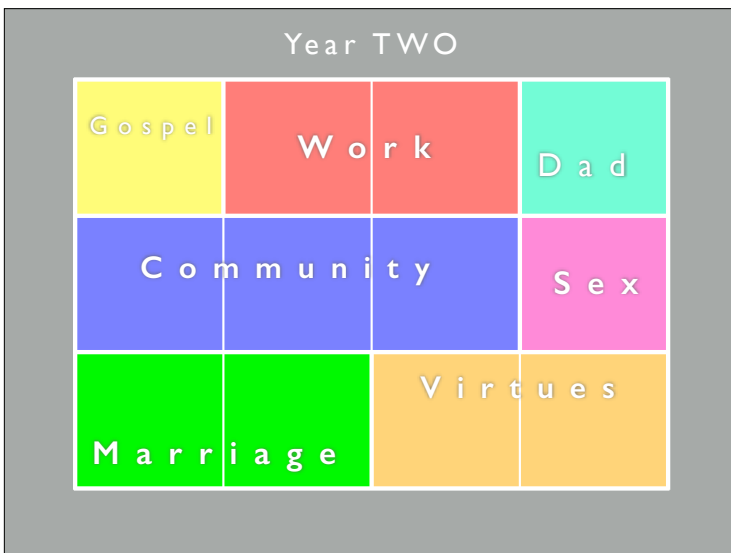
## Year ONE



Here is a recommended Discipleship Path that is broken down into 12 months.

- You may choose different resources than those listed here but exercise discernment. Remember that you are primarily studying the Bible and using resources to supplement your understanding.
- There should be an emphasis on continuing to build healthy biblical community throughout your first year.
- It is also wise to look at “The Gospel” early in your group journey in order to be sure each man understands the good news of salvation “by grace through faith” (Ephesians 2:8-9). Be certain that each man has truly come to faith in Jesus Christ and has assurance of his salvation. Don’t assume that church (or group) attendance, Christian family heritage, or biblical literacy are proof of regeneration.
- “My Story” is recommended as an overnight retreat that will help you to get to know one another more deeply (suggested templates are available). Alternatively, this could be done over the course of a month but you would want the entire group there for each session.

## Year TWO



This is another sample 12 month schedule of topics you could cover throughout your second year.

- Feel free to move them around as you deem best for your group.
- Do your best to address these topics in your first few years together.
