MENTORS STRONGLY ENCOURAGED

We suggest each team have at least one design professional to help with design and constructability.

FUND YOUR FOOD

Teams are responsible for purchasing/acquiring all CANS needed to create their structures. Seeking sponsorship is a great way to accomplish this.

A menu of available CANS for order through Wegmans will be provided. No glass, alcohol, 'junk' or expired food allowed.

SIZE LIMITS

Your structure must fit within the 10'W x 10'L x 8'H area assigned.

BUILD DAY RULES

Only 5 active builders may be in the assigned build area at a time. Additional team members will be provided a lounge area. There is no limit to the number of members on a team.

Teams may not exceed 12 hours to build their structures.

No props are allowed. Must be 100% unopened canned goods with labels intact.

Structures must be self-supporting. Foam core, cardboard, or plywood is allowable as a leveling device at no more than 1/4"; but must not be load bearing.

CANS can be joined with tape, velcro, fishing line, rubber bands, zip straps, and wire. As long as deCANstruction is easy and all cans and labels are intact.

No Permanent affixing of cans allowed. i.e. welding, gluing.

Team Captain Packet will be provided at time of entry.

Team Meetings will be held after the entry deadline, time and place TBD.

DESIGN SUBMISSION

Teams must provide a structure title, written description, design concept sketch, overall dimensions, and a detailed list of foods and number of CANS used to the CANstruction State College Committee. Refer to your welcome packet after registering for more information*.

*This information is a corporate requirement and must be submitted to the national committee.
