### **EXPANDING THE REACH OF YOUR GENEROSITY**

Thanks to the hard work, dedication and generosity of so many wonderful community members, donors, volunteers and staff over the past several years, the State College Food Bank (SCFB) is in a stronger position than ever to combat food

insecurity in Centre County.

In 2019, the Food Bank and all its contributors worked hard to assist and uplift our own clients, as well as many more in the surrounding community. In 2019 the amount of food donated increased from roughly 5000,000 in 2018 to almost more than 519,000. In addition to the individuals and



families we fed within our own facility in 2019, we were also able to increase the magnitude of our "re-donations" — surplus food that the SCFB is able to distribute to other organizations, individuals and food pantries in need of assistance. As a result, the Food Bank increased its amount of re-donated food, from roughly 73,000 pounds in 2018 to 88,182 in 2019. The hope for 2020 is to continue to build on that growth.



Because of the generous donations we receive from our community and local businesses, the Food Bank is able to provide a service that we are extremely proud of: increasing food security for individuals and families who do not qualify for state or federal food assistance but are still very much in need. Thanks to the incredible efforts of our donors and supporters, the Food Bank is able to go above and beyond for those in need. Looking toward the future, it is crucial to remain stronger than ever in regard to community-based food drives.
