Supplies for Stone Wrapping with 2 wires

• Round Wire Twist method	• Square Wire & half round wrap method
<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A stone with a point• 22 gauge round wire (craft or dead soft precious metal)• Quilters tape or masking tape	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A stone with a point• 21 or 22 gauge square wire (craft or dead soft precious metal)• 22 gauge half round wire (craft or precious metal)• Quilters tape or masking tape

Tools

- Wire cutter - (flush cutter is best)
- Round Nose Pliers
- Flat nose pliers
- Chain Nose Pliers .
