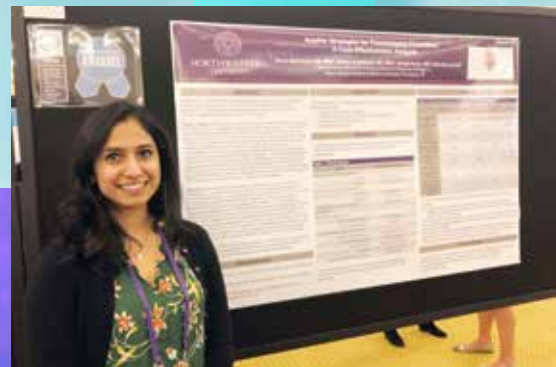

DEAR FRIENDS OF THE FOUNDATION FOR SMFM,

The year 2019 marked my last year as Chair of the Foundation for SMFM, a position I have held since the fall of 2013. I have been privileged to serve you and am most appreciative for the support of the Foundation Board of Directors, Dr. Brian Iriye and the other SMFM Presidents who served during my tenure, the Board of SMFM, and the members and corporate sponsors who have supported the Foundation. With your help, we have accomplished a lot. In the last six years we have created a mission, "To advance care in pregnancy through research and education," changed our name to the Foundation for SMFM, expanded our programs from three to eight and increased the corpus from \$3.35 to \$7.69 million, with a goal of reaching \$8 million by the end of 2020.

We rely on contributions from the membership of SMFM to sustain our programs. The number of SMFM members who give annually to the Foundation has increased substantially from 133 in 2014 to 622 in 2019. Thank you!

The American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology (ABOG) Educational Foundation continues to support our Bridge Award. This award provides funding for physician scientists as they persevere to attain independent funding. The results from this program have been outstanding, and we are most appreciative of this essential support.



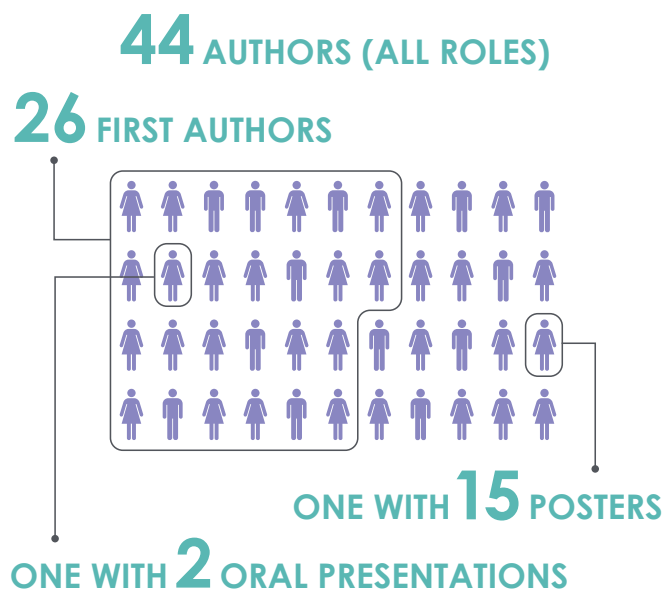

Foundation Awardees* at 2019 SMFM Meeting

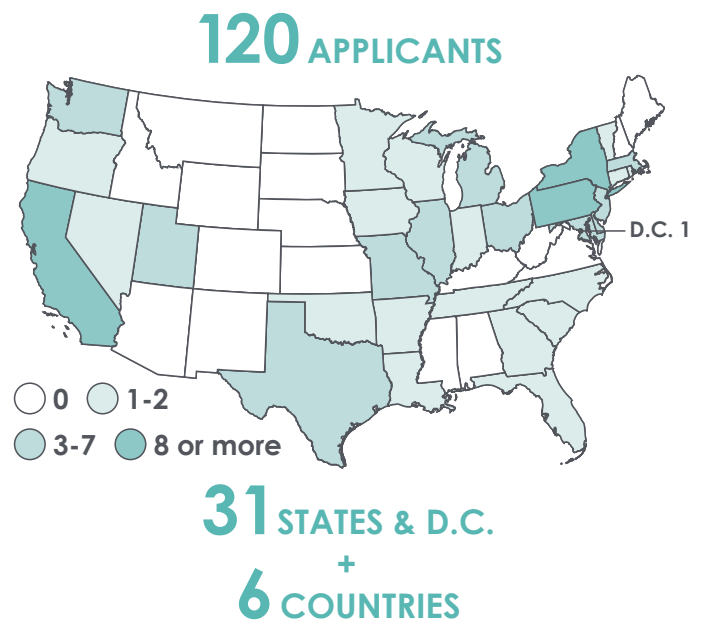

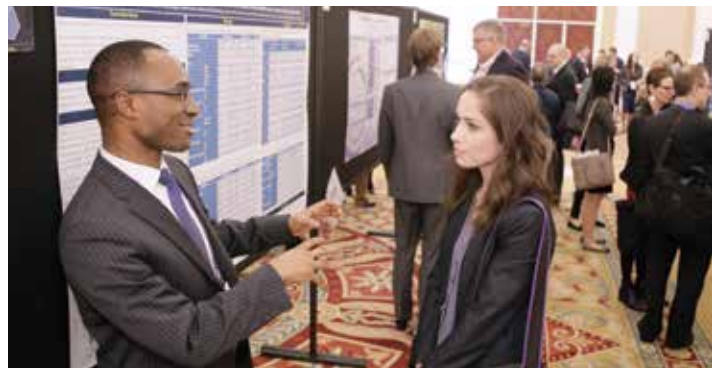

SMFM/AAOGF Scholars Program

Our premier research training scholarship, funded jointly with the American Association of Obstetricians and Gynecologists Foundation (AAOGF), is designed for future academic physician leaders who seek additional research training in maternal-fetal medicine. Applicants for this highly selective three-year award must have recently completed MFM subspecialty training or be in the second or third year of an ABOG-approved MFM fellowship program. The total annual funding for each scholar is \$120,000.

Decoding the Cervicovaginal Metabolome-Microbiome Interface: Potential Mechanisms of Spontaneous Preterm Birth



Sequelae of prematurity remains the leading cause of neonatal morbidity and mortality worldwide. Recent studies have demonstrated strong associations between non-optimal cervicovaginal microbiota and spontaneous preterm birth. It is hypothesized that cervicovaginal microbiota can trigger cervical remodeling. We propose to elucidate metabolome-microbiome interactions governing cervicovaginal epithelial disruption and premature cervical remodeling through *in vitro* and *in vivo* metabolomic experimental approaches. Select microbial metabolites may not only serve as more accurate predictive biomarkers for spontaneous preterm birth, but also carry potential as therapeutics in restoring or maintaining cervicovaginal health in pregnancy, thereby blocking the cascade of events that lead to aberrant cervical remodeling and spontaneous preterm birth.

Bridge Funding Award

The Foundation introduced a one-year bridge grant of \$75,000 in 2015, made possible with generous support from the ABOG Educational Foundation. The award is designed to stabilize the research program of a promising physician scientist on the path to obtaining independent research funding in the field of maternal-fetal medicine.

Fetal Brain-Placental Immune Activation in Maternal Obesity

The Edlow Laboratory is focused on the effects of maternal obesity on fetal brain development and offspring behavior, and how these effects are modified by fetal sex. Data from large epidemiologic studies demonstrate that offspring of obese mothers are at increased risk for cognitive deficits, autism spectrum disorder, ADHD, anxiety and depression, and disordered eating, but there is a gap in knowledge about the underlying mechanisms. The lab's broad goal is to use preclinical models to elucidate mechanisms underlying these neurodevelopmental morbidities in offspring of obese females. Ultimately, it is anticipated that this work will provide targets for a lifestyle/behavioral intervention, and for prenatal therapies that could be given orally to obese pregnant women, to reverse or ameliorate deleterious structural and functional changes. Dr. Edlow's Bridge Funding project tests the hypothesis that placental and fetal brain immune activation is a key mechanism underlying offspring hippocampal learning deficits in maternal obesity. Bridge Funding provided critical support to Dr. Edlow's research program in 2019, before she learned that her NIH R01 application of the same name ("Fetal Brain-Placental Immune Activation in Maternal Obesity") was funded.

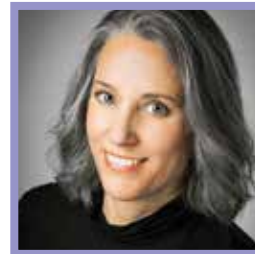

Quality Improvement Research Award

The goal of this award, supported by an educational grant from Hologic, is to encourage SMFM members, especially those who practice in community hospitals and private practice settings, to pursue quality improvement research related to prematurity, to increase SMFM quality improvement publications, and further evidence-driven quality improvement and patient safety measures that support SMFM's mission and vision. Reproductive Health Mini-Sabbatical Grants

The Reproductive Health Mini-Sabbatical provides opportunities for MFMs to gain clinical expertise or complete a research project in risk assessment, counseling, and treatment and access to reproductive health services for women at high-risk for maternal mortality and/or severe maternal morbidity. Two awards of up to \$10,000 each were available in 2019 for short-term research projects or clinical training experiences. These grants are a component of the Reproductive Health Project for Maternal-Fetal Medicine, an initiative of SMFM to integrate family planning and reproductive health care services into maternal-fetal medicine practice.

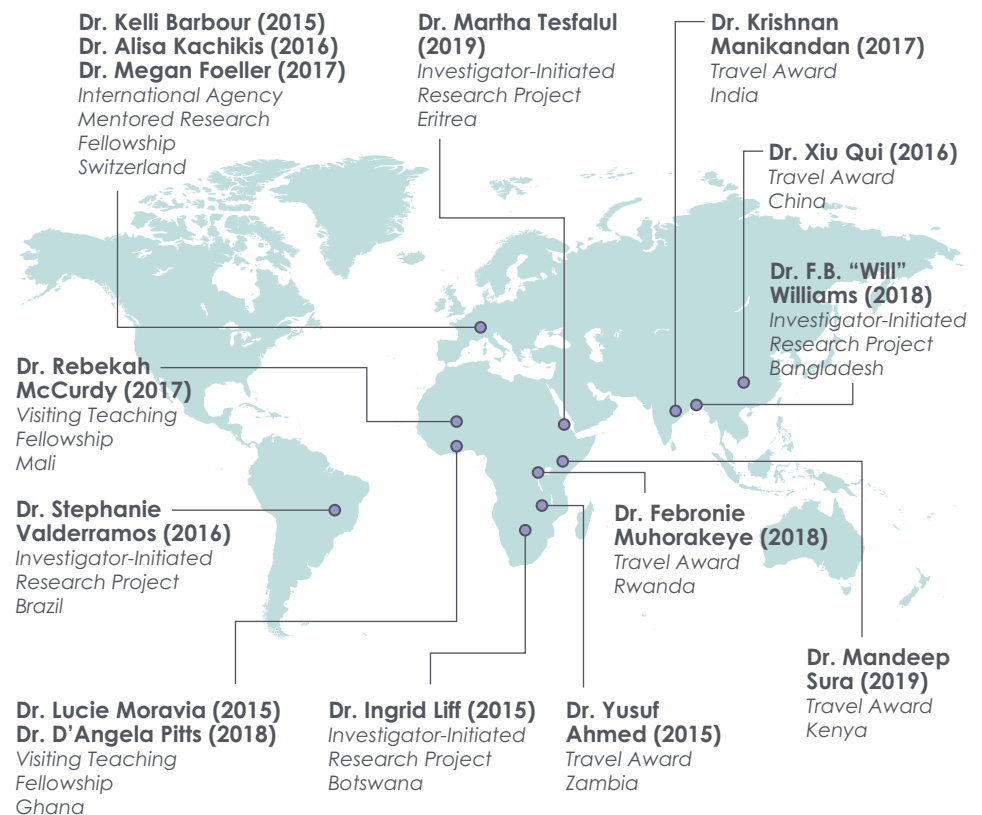

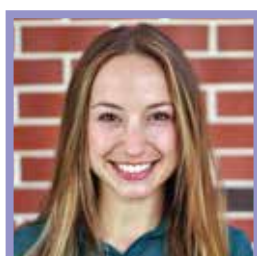

Literature Alert Series

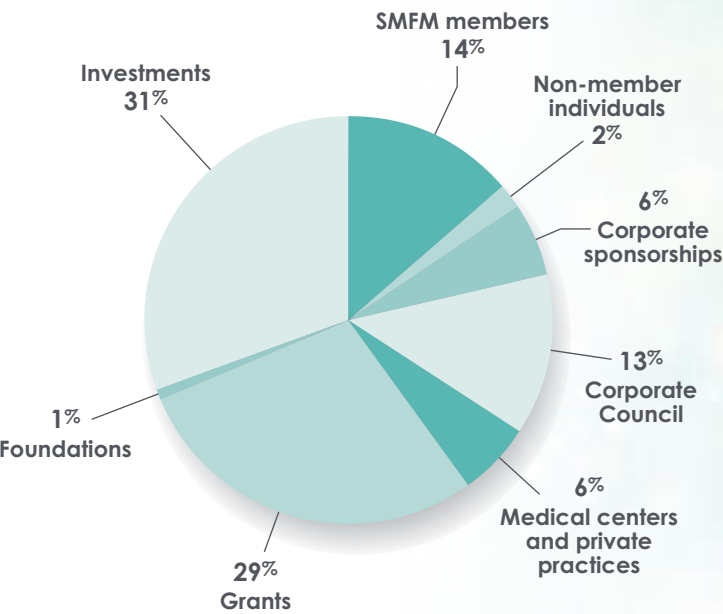
