Where Is Our Focus?

As believers in the body of Christ, our source of life is found in Christ. But because we are humans in physical form on this planet, we face the challenges of life. When we focus our attention upon those challenges, they have the potential to dominate our thoughts in our imaginations, thus influencing what is truth and reality in our heart beliefs.

When things look bad, then bad can have a dominating effect upon our hearts, bringing about uncertainty in our ability to trust God.

There is a story about Smith Wigglesworth, a minister in England alive during the Second World War, where he refused to allow a newspaper in his house. He would only allow the Word of God to be the dominant influence upon his heart.

This man lived where war was taking place, and if you consider the average person living in England during the war, any information that they could obtain about the war would have been of extreme importance to them because of the danger they constantly faced.

But here was a man who was not ignoring that there was a war but, because of his relationship with Jesus, understood that there was a spiritual value that was of far greater importance than just having natural knowledge alone, which would have led his heart to trust in himself.

Proverbs says it this way in chapter 3, verse 5: "Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding" (NKJV).

The keyword is about trust. The ability of our hearts to trust in Jesus is found in the word "all." It is all of your heart in your ability to trust that will bring about the right spiritual results. Where you focus is where you will go!

Our focus is Jesus. Truth found from experiencing the Spirit of Christ, where revelation knowledge is given by the same Spirit, will reveal God's perspective.

Hebrews 12:2-3 (ASV)

- ² Looking unto Jesus the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising shame, and hath sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- ³ For consider him that hath endured such gainsaying of sinners against himself, that ye wax not weary, fainting in your souls.

Leaning to our own understanding comes when we relate to life no differently than an unbeliever, where understanding is determined by natural knowledge alone. To consume our focus upon all the natural information of life's circumstances taking place in the world is what it means "to lean" (Prov. 3:5). Our own understanding is produced by us through our intellect. There is a danger in trusting in our own intellect to determine what is truth to our hearts. If we establish beliefs within our hearts through this manner, then we will experience what the Bible calls unbelief. Unbelief is always about us.

Proverbs 13:12 (NKJV) Hope deferred makes the heart sick.

When it seems like the promise of good is taking such a long time to manifest in your life and this focus dominates your thoughts, then an emotional sickness can be produced within your heart. Filling your heart with hope, an expectation of God's goodness, does not come by accident but by putting your focus on Jesus.
