Speaking to the Issues of Your Heart

Luke 17:4-5 (NKJV, brackets mine)

⁴ "And if he [your brother] sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times in a day returns to you, saying, 'I repent,' you shall forgive him."

⁵ And the apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith."

The apostles were challenged by Jesus saying to forgive seven times in a day, which basically means to always forgive. With the scenario Jesus presented to them, the disciples believed that it moved forgiveness beyond human ability.

To have to forgive a person who is constantly sinning against you in such a short amount of time as one day could cause you to believe that the person can't be sincere and obviously deserves punishment, not forgiveness.

When our way is deeply established within our hearts in believing we are right, this is what binds us to our own perspective, blinding us to God's perspective. The thing about an attitude is, it's a settled way of thinking about something.

In Luke 17:3, Jesus said, *"Take heed to yourselves."* This warning was to the one being offended, not the one causing the offense.

The disciples' response was that they believed they needed more faith. They saw this manner of forgiving as almost impossible. They believed faith was the answer, as the disciples said, "Lord, increase our faith."

Look at Jesus' response.

Luke 17:6 (NKJV)

⁶ So the Lord said, "If you have faith as a mustard seed, you can say to this mulberry tree, 'Be pulled up by the roots and be planted in the sea,' and it would obey you."

Jesus said that if you had faith as a mustard seed, which is a very tiny seed, you could tell a mulberry tree to pull itself up, roots and all, and to plant itself in the ocean. And it will obey you!

An old Jewish perspective was that large bodies of water were to be feared. The people would refer to the sea as an abyss. They saw it as a place of darkness, something unpredictable, an image of terror, and a danger like hell.

To cast something into the sea would put it in a place they would never go to retrieve it ever again. It would be out of their lives forever!

The disciples did not need more faith but, rather, a change concerning the issues of their heart beliefs.

Jesus gave a revelation understanding by telling us to *"say to the mulberry tree."* The mulberry tree is an external example, but the issue of forgiveness Jesus was addressing is an internal issue of the heart.

As believers, we can speak the truth of God's Word for the benefit of our hearts; through this, we can obtain God's perspective, which can resolve issues of unbelief. With words, we can speak directly to the issues of our hearts, commanding those issues to go from our lives, and this releases the power of the Holy Spirit to bring about a work of freedom in our hearts. The example Jesus used was a relationship issue involving forgiveness. The revelation truth He revealed, however, is also applicable toward unbelief in financial areas of life or to physical problems when it comes to wrong beliefs in receiving healing.

We can speak to external problems in life as well as internal problems in seeing the faithfulness of God manifest on our behalf.
