Our faith is the ability of our hearts to trust God, who is in Spirit form and not in a human form with a natural body. Sometimes just saying that we are trusting God can seem so impersonal. But if we come to understand who the Person of God is as our Heavenly Father who loves us with such a great love that He gave us the greatest gift—the life of His only Son—suddenly our way of relating becomes personal and relational.

Knowing the Person behind the promise is so important in receiving a promise given by Him. You see, faith comes through the Word of God, and faith works through love.

Romans 10:17 (NKJV) So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

This is a principle in God's Word: faith that comes by hearing and receiving a revelation of righteousness that was given by grace are what opens our hearts to the Person behind the promise. The Word of God is full of the faith of God and capable of producing faith in the heart of a believing person. In Luke 11:28, Jesus said, "Blessed are those who hear the word of God and keep it!" Hearing through the ears and faith that enters the heart, resulting in obedience that lives the revealed truth, produces God's results.

Luke 8:18 (AMPC)

Be careful therefore how you listen. For to him who has [spiritual knowledge] will more be given; and from him who does not have [spiritual knowledge], even what he thinks and guesses and supposes that he has will be taken away.

It is love that makes faith work, that produces faith within the heart of a believing person. You can trust someone who truly loves you.

Galatians 5:6 (NKJV)

For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision nor uncircumcision avails anything, but faith working through love. It is not circumcision nor uncircumcision; in other words, it's not what a person does through their external self-performance but what happens in and comes from their heart.

Love is what makes faith work. Love enables faith to function. Love brings about faith's operation, as love initially activates faith.

Galatians 5:6 (AMPC)

For [if we are] in Christ Jesus, neither circumcision nor uncircumcision counts for anything, but only faith activated and energized and expressed and working through love.

If you are having difficulty with trusting God with your faith, then you need a revelation of how much God loves you—a revelation of His grace and His unconditional love that will bring about a heartfelt faith.
