

Grace has everything to do with God towards us and nothing to do with us towards Him. In the first part of Colossians 3:4 we are told that we have died, and our

Building update

When we originally purchased our ministry building here in Colorado many people were having trouble selling as our housing market was experiencing severe trouble, including the seller of our building. As a result of this for years he had not properly maintained the quality of the building or invested in upgrades in the area of windows, paint, carpet, phone system, parking lot, landscape and many smaller areas.

Before and after moving into the building we put in a lot of work along with the help of many people in bringing the quality of the building to where it is today. It's really a beautiful building with a wonderful appearance inside and outside. We waited on upgrading areas of the windows, phone system and landscape because our focus was on paying off the building and saving the ministry thousands of dollars in interest, which by God's blessings was accomplished within 5 years.

As the winter weather here in Colorado is ending, we are now beginning to focus on window replacements, some minor landscaping and eventually replacement of our phone system which we have been having difficulty with and is so old that parts for repair are no longer produced. Anyone who would like to give unto these areas can give into our general fund for these different projects. We estimate the new phone system at around \$10,000 dollars with window replacements at around \$30,000 dollars. As the funds are available, we will go ahead and begin to replace more and more of the windows beginning with the most important windows until all the work is accomplished.

Lisa and I, are very grateful to you our friends and partners of this ministry as together we are seeing lives changed. We believe that our partners are greatly prospering spirit, soul and body as you experience increase in the seed you have sown multiplying and increase in the fruits of your righteousness. God's richest blessings in Christ are already yours. Believe and establish this truth in your heart and have an open heart to receive all that God has given you in Christ Jesus.

So how does it actually work? How do you receive the manifestations? How do you receive healing in your body?





The condition of our own heart can blind us to the fullness of the Father's love. Coming to the end of self is important, but it does not bring a complete change of heart. It is only the beginning of change. This teaching will reveal the heart of two brothers, who each, in their own way, were full of themselves, but neither fully knew the heart of their own father. His heart towards them never changed, it was always a heart of unconditional love. Because of the condition of our own heart, we can be blind to the fullness of the Father's love, especially when there are strong judgments from the beliefs within your heart. It is one thing to know that God is love, even as it says in 1 John 4:8, that He is love. It is another thing to know in an experiential way, as revealed by the Holy Spirit, our Father's heart of love, as described in Luke 15:17-24. Jesus' parable of the lost son reveals the Father's true heart: "But when he was still a great way off, his father saw him and had compassion, and ran and fell on his neck and kissed him ... But the father said to his servants, 'Bring out the best robe and put it on him, and put a ring on his hand and sandals on his feet. And bring the fatted calf here and kill it, and let us eat and be merry; for this my son was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' And they began to be merry."
