"Best Robe"

This robe would have been made of pure wool, which speaks of Christ's righteousness. Christ's righteousness is superior to self-righteousness as it was not a robe this man put on himself but the robe was put on him.

Romans 5:17 (KJV)

For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.

Isaiah 61:10 (KJV)

I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh himself with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth herself with her jewels.

"Ring"

The ring was a symbol of authority, revealing that this was a person of dignity and wealth. This speaks of our self-worth being established in Christ and all the promises, given as a gift in Christ, that are now ours.

"Shoes"

In ancient times, those who were taken captive had their shoes removed. Also, servants and slaves went without shoes. The father having shoes put upon his feet speaks of the wayward man no longer being captive and a slave to sin but being a son and having sonship, a place in the family.

Ephesians 1:3-6 (NKJV)

³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ, ⁴ just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, ⁵ having predestined us to adoption as sons by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, ⁶ to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He made us accepted in the Beloved.

For Christians, Christmas celebrates the birth of our Savior, Jesus Christ. Jesus is the greatest and most precious gift a God of love could give to His creation.


John 3:16-17 (CEV)
