

CLPMI's Year in Review

 Some renovations were also accomplished here at our ministry offices, and the ministry truck was paid in full—with much gratitude to our partners and friends!
- October We attended the Andrew Wommack Ministries Ministers' Conference in Woodland Park, Colorado, and then ministered at Charis Christian Center in Colorado Springs. We also hosted guests for the conference and were able to record more teachings for YouTube and our partners.
- November This month began with ministry at a church in Texas, and then we traveled on to a church and conference

in Florida. After those meetings, we ministered at another church in Florida and at a Bible college.

This year, that has been an outreach that has helped us reach so many here in the US and around the world.

Redemptive Love Ministries International

Pastor Ramin Parsa once pastored a church of over 200 people in Los Angeles, California. Almost all of those congregants were Iranians whom, I believe, Pastor Ramin led to the Lord. When we ministered in his church, four Muslims accepted Jesus as their Lord and Savior. I was also able to minister with him over airwaves that were broadcast into Iran. In Iran, they have called him an Israeli spy, which was broadcast all over Iran.

Ramin has a powerful testimony of experiencing Jesus in how he came to accept Him in Iran and how he led all his brothers and most of his sisters to Jesus. He witnessed and led so many people to the Lord that the Muslims tried to kill him by stabbing him with a knife. But they failed in their attempt and only wounded him. His bold witnessing put his family and friends in danger, so he fled Iran, traveling to Turkey, with no passport and only a small amount of money. In Turkey, he was connected by the direction of the Lord to an underground church of around fifty people. While he was involved with this church, it doubled in size, as he led around fifty Muslims to accept Jesus.

Another part of his testimony is that our government made him an American citizen, gave him an American passport, and brought him to America. On the way to America, the Lord gave him a warning. The Lord never warned him about all the danger he would experience in Iran and Turkey, but when he came to America, the Lord spoke to him, saying for him "not to leave his first love, Jesus." Boy, that speaks volumes!

Today Pastor Ramin is married to an Israeli woman, and they reside in Israel. There, they have a ministry in Jerusalem called Hope of Israel.

My main reason for sharing a portion of Ramin's testimony is that he is believing to purchase a church building in Jerusalem. Here at CLPMI, we are believing to be one of many each giving \$10,000 for this nearly 6,000-square-foot building so that it will be paid in full.
