They were not getting results in seeing the problem leave through prayer and were wondering what was wrong.

An excellent example of this is found in Mark 9, in the story of the father who brought his son to Jesus for healing deliverance.

Mark 9:17-18 (NKJV)

¹⁷ Then one of the crowd answered and said, "Teacher, I brought You my son, who has a mute spirit.

¹⁸ And wherever it seizes him, it throws him down; he foams at the mouth, gnashes his teeth, and becomes rigid. So I spoke to Your disciples, that they should cast it out, but they could not."

This boy had lived with this serious problem for years without ever experiencing any sign of physical freedom; in fact, it only got worse. The effect of this on the heart of the father was devastating. Over the years, no matter how much effort he put into trying to obtain freedom for his son, there were never any positive results. This led to the problem seeming as if it were all-powerful and produced many different issues of unbelief within the heart of the imagination of this father.

Mark 9:24 (NKJV)

Immediately the father of the child cried out and said with tears, "Lord, I believe; help my unbelief!"

problem can produce wrong beliefs in relationship to the problem. This is what the Bible calls unbelief. This unbelief within your heart hinders the release of the life of Christ that comes out of your spirit, which is where the Holy Spirit dwells, as the kingdom of God is within you.

You need to hate the problem hurting your child, instead of respecting the problem. In fact, you need the kind of attitude that you are going to **kill** this problem with the power of God. You will discover that better results come through preparing your heart with God's perspective in relationship to the problem. Allowing the Holy Spirit to open up the Word of God, resulting in it having a dominant influence, is very effective.
