In this passage, Paul was writing to the Romans to let them know that even though he was coming to Rome, he was on his way to Spain afterwards. Paul hoped the believers in Rome would be a financial part of helping him go on to minister in Spain.

Similarly, we are excited to share with you that overseas ministry has opened up again in the U.K.! We have been asked to come in the months of April and May and minister at Healing Is Here Conferences in Scotland and in England. We also will be ministering in churches and Bible colleges.

This is an area of the world for which we received a prophecy over twenty-five years ago. We were told to go to England, Ireland, and Scotland and bring God's presence to His people.

Every time we go, it is wonderful—all the spiritual fruit we see in salvations, healings, people set free from bondages, and those
