Hearing the Voice of God by the Holy Spirit

One of the purposes of our prayer language—speaking in tongues—is that it directly benefits us by making us sensitive to the Holy Spirit in hearing His voice. Jude 1:20 says that we build ourselves up on our most holy faith, praying in the Holy Ghost.

One of the first ways—that I believe has the greatest benefit to us personally—is when the Holy Spirit speaks to us through the Word of God. When the Holy Spirit reveals to us revelation truth from the Word of God, that truth has now gone beyond just intellectual information to us. Truth of God's Word of who we are in Christ in our spirits is manifesting in our souls, transforming us into His image where we have God's perspective revealed to us.

When you read and study the Word of God, believe for the Holy Spirit to be your teacher. If you do this, you will be ready with an expectation and dependency on the Holy Spirit, and this will help open your heart to value His voice.

A second way is through the wisdom that James 1:5 promises: "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him" (KJV).

When the Holy Spirit speaks to us, the wisdom we are believing for as an answer to prayer manifests in the form of *knowing* that goes beyond natural reasoning, out of the intellect. We suddenly know something that is a direct benefit to what we are believing God for in His promises.

A third way is where we personally hear His voice from within. This can possibly manifest differently with each believer, as the Holy Spirit has a personal relationship with each of us. In 1 Kings 19:11-12, Elijah did not hear God through external means—through the wind or an earthquake or the fire—but in a still, small voice. Our bodies are the temple of the Holy Spirit, as the Godhead dwells within us.

One of my first experiences I had with the Holy Spirit as a young Christian that brought about listening inwardly to His voice over the thoughts of my inner voice happened while I was working in construction in a historical district.

I was focusing on the physical work at hand but, at the same time, enjoying worship music on the inside of me. It was like someone had taken a music box and put it deep down on the inside of me. This went on for several minutes before it consciously dawned on me that music was *on the inside of me*. When I stopped working and put my focus directly on the supernatural experience, the music quickly went right up to my mind. Now when the Holy Spirit speaks to me through worship music, it is immediately in my mind.

The Holy Spirit can speak to your mind, and you can know the difference between your thoughts and His voice. Remember that when the Holy Spirit speaks to you, He always speaks what the Father and Son are speaking, as They are one.

The fourth way the Holy Spirit can speak to you is by a word of knowledge or a word of wisdom or prophecy (1 Cor. 12:8, 10). Many times, this is an external form of communication coming through others to you, but it can also come by the Holy Spirit from within. A word of wisdom given to you through others should bear witness with what has already been revealed to you from God. If someone is giving you a prophetic word that is completely new, it is wisdom to ask the Lord for a confirmation that what is being spoken is coming from Him. Many Christians have made decisions based on words of prophecy that they later regretted moving forward on without confirmation.

Acts 2:17-18 (KJV)

¹⁷ And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:

¹⁸ And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy.

- 19 Quench not the Spirit.

This window installation will complete the exterior repair on our ministry building, which also included resurfacing our parking area with a product that will extend the life of the lot.
