

Devotional: Healing Does God Work Through Doctors? No!

God has given us all things through Jesus Christ, and Jesus is our example of how we receive from God, our heavenly Father. In the area of healing, there is no example of Jesus sending someone to a doctor instead of praying for them Himself. The same is true with the disciples when they prayed for healing. In Luke 9, Jesus gave them authority and power for prayer. Jesus was the one who taught them how to pray, as they were His disciples.

Christians who say that this is the way God heals—through a doctor—are not basing their belief on the Word of God but on human opinion, having formed a judgment within their hearts.

Everything we receive from God comes through Jesus because of the cross. As Matthew 8:17 reminds us, Jesus took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses at the cross.

Can God Work Through Doctors? Yes!

God working through doctors is determined by the faith of the person believing.

This is not the way our heavenly Father has chosen primarily to work, but He will respond to faith in and from the heart of a believer. Some Christians have faith in their hearts that God is working through the doctor, and many Christians have unique testimonies of God's faithfulness. Some Christians have never learned how to receive healing through Jesus but do trust Him with faith in their hearts.

Some Christians, though, will say that they are trusting God to work through a doctor, but they are not. They are self-deceived, having unbelief in their hearts rooted in fear. They are trying to trust God but are not resolving the issues of fear within their hearts.

Romans 8:6

For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.

They are not successful in trying to trust God because they are in human self-effort, being carnally minded. They are not experiencing the help of the Holy Spirit in teaching them the Word of God and how to be spiritually minded.

Some Christians who are dealing with this kind of unbelief quote a part of Mark 9:24 in justifying the way that they are believing.



Mark 9:24

And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; help thou mine unbelief.

Instead of going through the process of the Word of God working within their hearts and uprooting the fear, they will say, "Lord, I believe but help my unbelief." They are asking the Lord to do *for* them what His Word tells *them* to do.

In Mark 9, Jesus could have healed the father's son anytime He chose to. With wisdom, Jesus was ministering first to the father because of the serious issues of unbelief within his heart. After the son was healed, this kind of unbelief in the father's heart could have

negatively influenced the son's heart beliefs, especially as the father-son relationship was very close in this culture.
