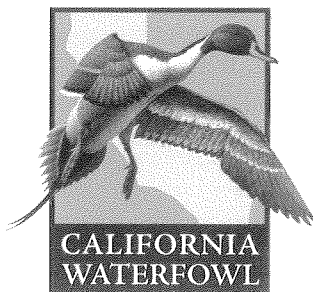

**RE: AB 760 (Dickinson) – OPPOSE**

Dear Assembly Member Bocanegra:

The California Waterfowl Association (CWA) urges you to oppose AB 760 (Dickinson), which would place a .05 cent tax on each piece of ammunition sold in California.

Our Association opposes this measure due to its unwarranted impact on licensed hunters who purchase shotgun and rifle ammunition for legitimate sporting purposes. Not only is this type of sporting ammunition used in relatively few crimes overall in California, but the excellent safety record of licensed hunters (e.g. in most years there are only about two dozen total safety accidents from hunting) who purchase most of this ammunition clearly demonstrates that they are using it responsibly. Unfortunately, AB 760 indiscriminately penalizes hunters and other law abiding citizens for the illegal or irresponsible acts of others, rather than narrowly focusing its requirements on those who directly contribute to gun violence.

It should also be noted that there is already a significant (11%) tax placed on all ammunition via the federal Pittman-Robertson Act. That tax helps fund critically important wildlife habitat work on state wildlife areas, including those administered by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, as well as hunter education activities. In addition, ammunition purchases constitute a significant portion of the overall costs of participating in waterfowl and dove hunting, for example, which generate other conservation monies via hunting license and associated stamp sales. By further taxing ammunition and increasing the cost of hunting, we believe AB 760 would create a financial disincentive for hunters to generate these wildlife conservation revenues.

For these reasons, please oppose AB 760 when it is considered before your committee.
