You are scheduled for a waterfowl hunt held by California Waterfowl. Please arrive promptly by 4:00 pm on Friday evening for dinner, blind assignments, safety briefing, etc.

Women's Grizzly Ranch Duck Hunt checklist-2023

Clothing – Layers layers layers!

- Saturday Hunt clothing-if you need to borrow jacket or waders, we have some to loan!
- Saturday non-hunt clothing – what you'll wear after the hunt. Best to wear pants loose enough for base layers underneath them – it makes changing in the parking lot less awkward.
- Sleepwear. We will be sharing rooms in beds and a few cots. There is a chance male guides will join us for the evening, so even if you normally sleep in the buff, you may not want to this weekend. ☺

Duck hunt clothing:

- Hip or chest duck hunting waders
- Thick socks
- Long johns/base layer to prevent chafing or icky sweating inside of waders-NO COTTON
- Light and warm shirt layers (check weather)
- Duck hunting jacket
- Camo cap for duck hunting
- REQUIRED-Walking stick(s) or poles for safety
- Gloves (if not camo, go for black or brown)
- Headlamp – just makes it easier walking in the dark

Documents (you will be required to show these on

Personal items:

- Cell phone – reception can be decent, depending on your carrier
- Toiletries
- Medications
- Sleeping bag and Pillow,
Sleeping pad for comfort/air mattress-optional
- Ear plugs
- Slippers-wood floors are cold in the morning!
- Feminine Products – nothing worse than the unexpected arrival of your period while hunting
- Lotion – hands can get dry and chapped while hunting!
- Lip balm – ditto!

Gun and ammunition:

- Shotgun – if you are borrowing a gun, confirm that it will be brought
- 2-3 boxes of waterfowl shot (non-toxic, #2 or #3 shot) – 2-3 boxes of goose loads (non-toxic, #1, BB, or BBB)

Miscellaneous hunt items:

- Soda or bottled water for duck hunt
- Christmas hunt date-Bring a white elephant gift! \$25 limit, let's have some fun!
- BYOB! Bring your special stuff to share with

- Valid 2017-18 hunting license
- HIP stamp or validation
- State duck stamp or validation
- Federal duck stamp – affix to license and sign

- Special Snacks for duck hunt
- Trash bag for picking up spent shells
- Ear protection (we'll have earplugs we can provide)
- Eye protection – if you don't wear prescription glasses, bring shooting glasses
- Mosquito repellent (ideally spray so you can use it on clothing)
- Cooler and ice packs to take ducks home with you

When you arrive

- Check in
- Pick your room and your bunk and neatly group your things in the designated areas.
- Keep guns/ammunition locked up in your vehicle until ready to leave for hunt/shooting area in the morning.
- Dogs should be kept on a leash or kenneled until the morning. No dogs are allowed inside the buildings. **All dogs need to be cleared by the coordinator before signing up.**

What to expect

1. Volunteer guides can take care of all gun safety, shooting instruction, duck calling, and bird retrieval, but you are encouraged to practice your new skills!
2. Dinner, breakfast and lunch is provided all weekend.
3. The hunt will conclude at 10:00 am on Saturday. Lunch will follow roughly at 11:00 pm.

Directions Grizzly Ranch Address:

4179 Van Sickle Road, Suisun City 94585

- Hwy 80 to Fairfield
- Take Hwy 12 East toward Suisun City.

Note: When you get off Hwy 80 you will travel a short distance before going under a bridge. Hwy 12 is the first left after going under the bridge.

- After 3.6 miles, Right onto Grizzly Island Rd
- After 5.4 miles, stay Right over Montezuma Slough Bridge, you will see signs for Rush, Ranch, ignore that and continue onto Grizzly Road.
- After 3.3 miles, Right onto Van Sickle Road, dirt road, where white fence on your right ends

Note: You should see “Welcome to Grizzly Island Wildlife Area”, look for white

fence. If you get to the Grizzly Island Wildlife Area you have gone too far.

- After 0.4 miles, Right into Grizzly Ranch There will be a large gate that says Grizzly Ranch. Drive through that.
