

# Paper Duck Call

## Materials:

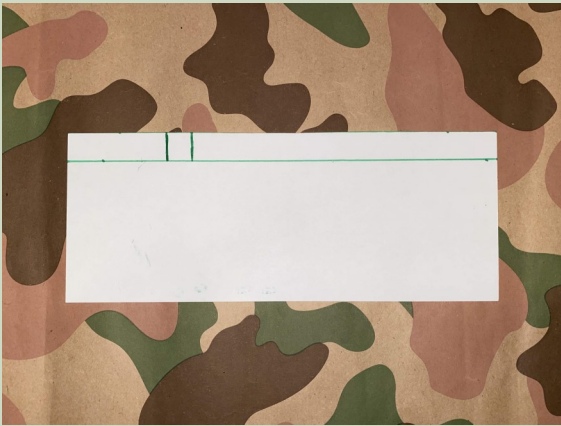
- Construction paper
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Tape



1. Take a piece of construction paper and place it landscape in front of you. Measure 3 and a 1/2 inches in and draw a line straight down. Then cut along the line.



2. Using the smaller rectangle of paper, measure in a 1/2 inch on the shortest side and draw a line straight down.



3. Position the paper with the line at the top (landscape). Measure in 2 and a 1/2 inches, and draw a 1/2 inch by 1/2 inch square.



4. Cut along the long line you drew, removing all of the paper **except** the square.



5. Using a pencil, roll the paper into a tube.



6. Once all of the paper is rolled, secure the end of the paper with tape. Then, remove the pencil.



7. Take the square of paper and fold it over the opening of the tube, like a flap. To make sound, place your mouth on the opposite side and suck in!

If the flap of your call is sticking to the opening of the tube, try using a **thicker** piece of paper for the activity!
