On Saturday 8/22/2020, a GPS tagged hen mallard was found dead at Tule Lake Wildlife Refuge. The cause of death is suspected to be an outbreak of botulism at the wildlife refuge.

The individual had been on the refuge since 8/4/2020 and had previously been on the refuge from 6/29/2020 to 7/30/2020.

The individual was approximately 3 years old when tagged on her nest by the USGS on 4/19/2019. Since then, 939 GPS locations have been recorded.
