Sadly, sometimes children cannot live with their parents in their own home, so they live together in Emunah Children's Homes. Emunah helps give these children a secure and loving place to grow up and just be a kid. They go to school, participate in after-school activities, celebrate Shabbat and Chagim as well as birthdays together – just like you!

The children are also given the support they need to overcome their challenges and become happy grown-ups.





There are five Emunah Children's Homes in Israel and together with day care centres, schools and other programs, Emunah helps over 10,000 children and young adults every year!



DANNY, AGED 10

Danny moved into the Beit Elazraki Emunah Children's Home in Natanya, when he was 6 years old.

His parents could not look after him and his brothers anymore, so he was forced to move to Beit Elazraki. He still sees his parents occasionally, if they come to visit. They accept that Danny is better off living at Beit Elazraki, as they don't have jobs, and don't have enough money to feed and look after their family properly.

He is determined to make his life a success and tries hard to do well at school. He hopes to go to the army and university and one day have his own family.



LEAH, AGED 8

Leah was brought to Neve Michael Children's Emergency Center in Pardes Hannah, in the middle of a dark winter's night.

Police were called her to apartment when neighbours heard loud screaming and fighting from her parents. The Welfare authorities decided that her parents were not able to care for her in a normal family environment, and sent her to stay at Neve Michael.

Leah took a long time to feel comfortable at Neve Michael, and she spent a lot of time alone and crying. The staff noticed she was starting to eat more meals and smile more often. Leah now accepts that Neve Michael is a place that keeps her safe and nurtured. She doesn't see her parents anymore and is forming close relationships with the caring "parents", therapists and friends at Emunah.

TIPS FOR PLANNING A SUCCESSFUL FUNDRAISER

WHO?

Choose a friend or family member to assist you – working in teams is so much more fun!

WHAT?

Think of an idea – brainstorming helps! *See our brainstorming diagram for some inspiration...(page 8)

PLAN

Plan your event- think of when, where and how to run it with maximum benefit (what else can you do to make extra money?). Use our goal planner to help you (page 10)

INVITE

Use our Event invitation (page 19) or create your own –share with your friends and family and ask them to tell others to come too!

REGISTER

Register your event on our Fundraiser Page ([see page 11](#)), [create your own QR code \(page 12\)](#).
- Ask an adult to help you with this step and check if we can promote it to our Emunah community.

COLLECT

Collect everything you need leading up to your event and organise the details (talking it through with an adult can help here too)

COMPLETE

Complete your Fundraising Declaration so your event is official under Kids for Emunah. Display this at your event. Find it in your pack and on page 20)

DECORATE

Print out any extra posters, signs or bunting to decorate your event space (pgs 17-22)

RAISE \$\$

Work out how you'd like to collect money, and send it in to us (more info on page 13 + 14)

HAVE FUN

Take some pics of your event in action and have lots of fun!!!!

HOW TO REGISTER YOUR OWN EVENT

1. Ask an adult permission to register an event
2. Create a flyer or image for your event (optional)
3. Go to our website at
<https://emunah.org.au/fundraisers/create>
or scan our QR code

4. Click  Complete the online form and submit.

5. Find your fundraiser in the list - your event is now successfully registered - well done!

6. You can go back and make changes if you need to!

If you're still not sure about creating your own event, come volunteer at one of Emunah Australia's fundraising events instead or talk to a friend or family member and do something together!

HOW TO CREATE YOUR OWN UNIQUE QR CODE

SCAN ME

1. Ask an adult permission to search the web.
2. Go to our webpage at <https://emunah.org.au/fundraisers/create> or scan this code
3. Find your fundraiser in the list - click on it....
4. Get the URL from your fundraiser which should look like [https://emunah.org.au/fundraisers/\(Your event name here\)](https://emunah.org.au/fundraisers/(Your event name here))
5. Google "QR code generator" to choose a link, or go to "the-qrcode-generator.com" website
6. Enter your URL to generate your unique QR Code.
7. Save it on your computer and copy and paste and print it out wherever you want....
8. Test it out.... hope it works. if you need help, email us at info@emunah.org.au and we will help you!

HOW TO COLLECT MONEY AT YOUR EVENT



At your event people can pay you in different ways...



Cash - use your money box to collect and store cash.



Contactless credit card payments using our official tap and go device*
*contact us at info@emunah.org.au if you'd like to book this for your event (conditions apply).



Online payments/donations using
our QR code or your unique event code (if you created one yourself).

*You can watch your total go up as you raise more money! *

HOW TO DONATE THE MONEY YOU RAISED AFTER YOUR EVENT



Once you've completed your event and you are ready to donate any cash you received you can:



A) Count up your cash. Contact us at info@Emunah.org.au and we can come collect the cash

OR



B) ask an adult to assist you to do an online donation of the total cash raised through YOUR fundraising profile to donate to your total <https://emunah.org.au/fundraisers> (or use your QR code if you made one).

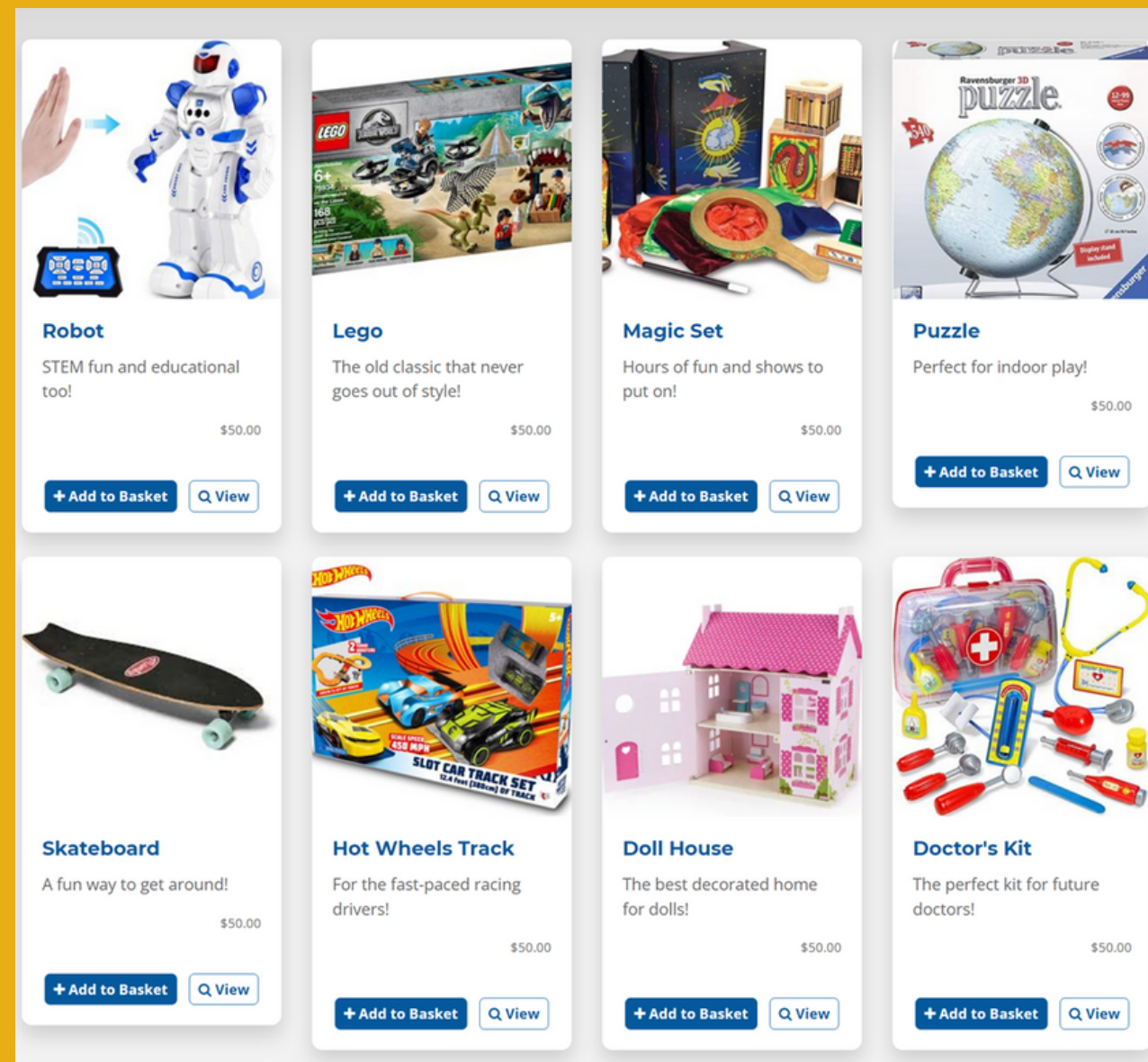

All Emunah events must be inclusive of the whole Jewish community therefore:



Food purchased for sale or served at your event must always be certified under Kosher Australia



If you wish to bake/cook (for humans), this must be using all Kosher certified ingredients in a Kosher home* (pet treats are exempt)

*if you need access to a Kosher kitchen, please let us know and we can provide one for you.

How to make Bunting

2. Cut string to length (remembering it should dip a bit in the middle and have extra space on sides to tie it up)
3. Space out your triangles and fold over edge and staple over the string, leaving gaps and string at the ends to tie it up
4. Hang up at your event to decorate the space
