Magdalena House is a transitional home that serves mothers and their children who have fled dangerous and abusive lives by providing transformation through education, nurturing community, and programming. We rescue the least and the lost, sharing hope for a new beginning.



## NEED

Over 80% of women and children experiencing homelessness have also experienced violence. In Texas, more than 39% of those victims are turned away from housing programs due to lack of space (tcfv.org).

Homeless mothers are extremely vulnerable and often lack the material resources, emotional well-being, and education to provide a safe, stable environment for their children. They live in fear, facing increased risk of further trauma.

Magdalena House supports mothers escaping family violence and human trafficking, aging out of foster care, and facing homelessness. We offer 24/7 support to create a stable, homelike environment, full of hope and accountability, where mothers and their children can succeed in school and life.
