You opened "so many doors" for Sharon!

Like many people, Sharon looks back on 2020 as a "bad time," but not because of the pandemic. Instead, it's because she was arrested and "things started going downhill from there."


She had no job, no transportation and eventually, no place to live. Homeless and desperate, Sharon survived by making her way from one shelter to another.

But one very good thing happened to Sharon last year. She found her way to the Open Door Mission. "They interviewed me and moved me right in," she remembers. Although she had been in other shelters, Sharon felt right away that Open Door was different. "When I was doing my intake, I felt like a weight was lifted off my shoulders. I wanted to cry, I wanted to pray. I had never had a feeling like that before."

Sharon tells us Open Door provided everything she needed to get her life back on track. With help from staff and counselors, she straightened out her legal issues, took care of all her paperwork, got a job and found a place to live independently.

"They have been such a blessing; they really opened so many doors for me," Sharon says. "All I had to do was walk through them."

One door Sharon walked through reconnected her with Jesus Christ. "I love God and I thank Him every day," Sharon says.



To anybody who is experiencing hardship, who feels lost and hopeless, Sharon strongly recommends Open Door. "The people there will really care for you. You might have given up on yourself, but they will never give up on you! They're very encouraging. If someone really wants to change their life, they should go to Open Door. It's the place to be."

As a result of the pandemic, in March 2020 we made the difficult decision to close the clothing room and turn our clothing operation to a grab-and-go style.

We have great news ... the clothing room is re-opened and we need your help!

We are looking for groups of volunteers (up to 6 people per shift) to help operate the clothing room. Job responsibilities include: sorting, hanging, concierge services and assisting those in need. The shifts that need to be filled are 9:00 AM - 12:00 PM and 1:00 PM - 4:00 PM on Monday through Friday.
