

Natasha was struggling to find shelter for her family. The problem was most shelters would not accept her eldest 16-year-old son. That kept them on the move from one place to another.

Then Natasha received a blessing together with a great loss. She gave birth to a healthy daughter, but that same night, her father passed away. Overcome with the grief of her father's passing, Natasha felt she could not go on by herself.

Open Door Mission was recommended to her, and she reached out. When she heard not only was she welcome, but her entire family as well, she was overcome with relief. The grief, stress and hopelessness began to melt away as she realized her children were going to a safe, healthy place.

Natasha herself is working on her CDL bus driving license. “Open Door is giving me the chance to get back on my feet, get a job and save money for my own place,” she proudly says.

“It has been so long since my children had their own home for Christmas. I am looking forward to providing for them and then giving back to other ladies at Open Door.”

As Natasha works toward her goals, she is beyond grateful for your support. “I am so thankful for everything I am given. My family came here this summer, and we are already learning how to begin new lives. I lost so much and been through so much trauma. Now there is nothing left but to elevate myself and get better!”
