

### **New Apartments** to Break the Cycle of Homelessness

The long-awaited conversion of a Mission property into permanent supportive housing has begun!

Earlier this year, Open Door Mission was notified that we will receive a grant to establish 24 permanent supportive apartments. The proposed apartments will be located at 226-234 West Main Street in an existing, vacant facility formerly known as the Miller Building. The Mission currently owns this facility which neighbors our Samaritan House emergency shelter.

The facility will undergo a substantial rehabilitation to become 13 studio apartments and 11 one-bedroom apartments. Open Door Mission will provide on-site support services for residents, including case management, job readiness training, financial management, skill training, and job search assistance. We hope that the apartments will be ready for occupancy by Spring 2022.

But relocating from Alabama didn't go as smoothly as Vicki had planned.

She arrived in Rochester right around the time the COVID outbreak started. "They were shutting everything down, so I was having a hard time finding a job." She tried staying with family, but "that can sometimes not be a good situation."
