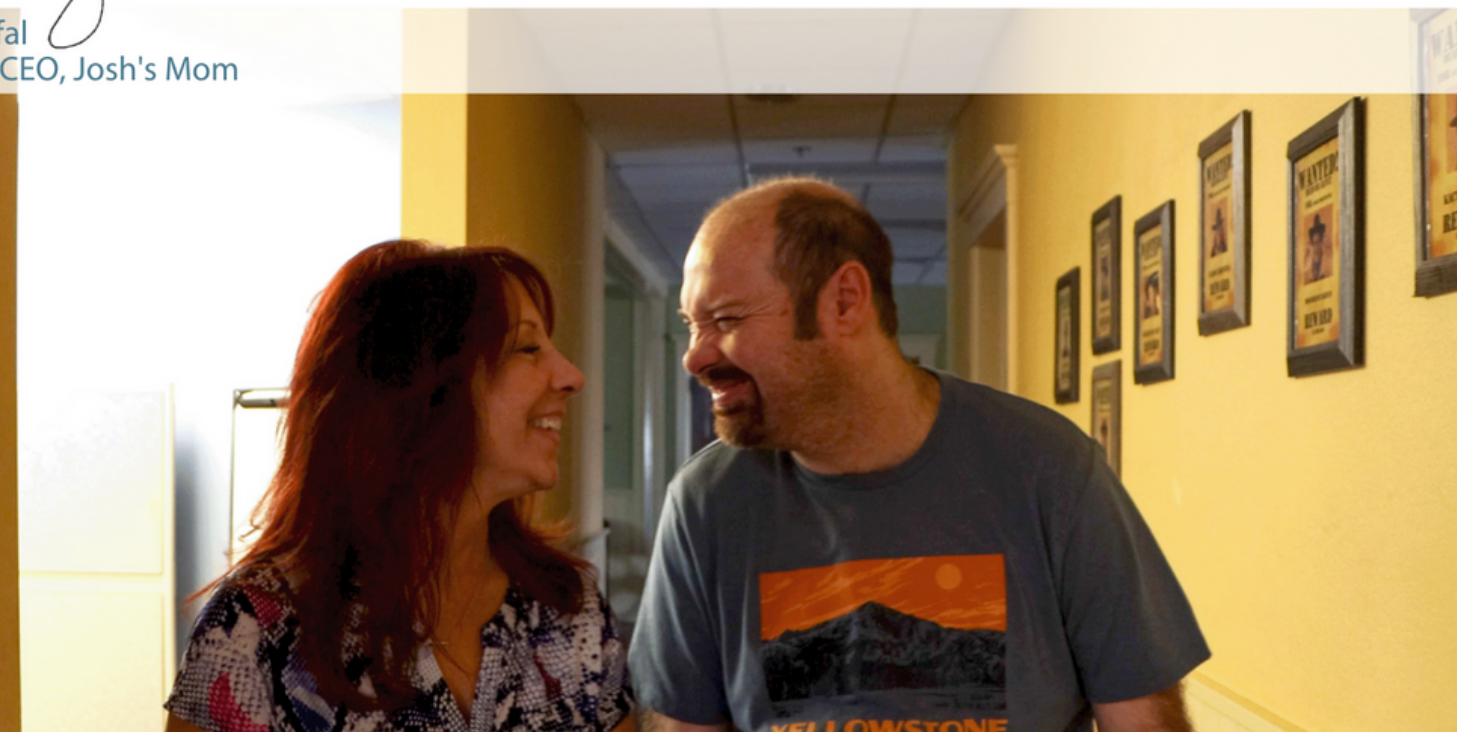

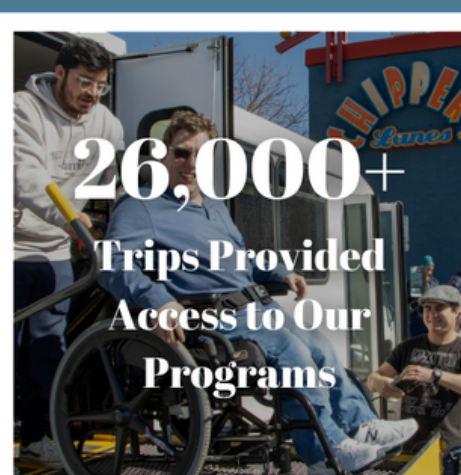
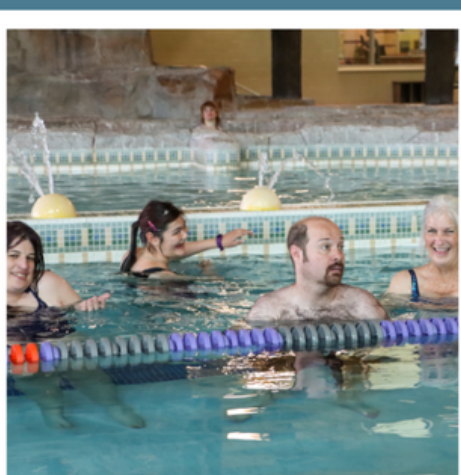

# Day Program

FRIENDS Day Program is guided by a person-centered philosophy and is designed to promote community inclusion and independence. We believe that when adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities are given the

opportunity and support to participate and contribute to the community, all of our lives are enriched.

Since success will look different to each individual we serve, FRIENDS staff takes the time to learn about a person's needs, interests, and goals. This approach allows our team to provide services that will align with what the person wants for their life.

Our Day Program holds morning and afternoon classes everyday Monday through Friday. Our participants choose classes that enhance their communication, encourage exercise and facilitate skill building. The program fosters social, mental, and physical health through classes such as Relationship Skills, Cooking, Sign Language, Spanish, Music, Cultural Arts, Aerial Gym, Self Defense, Swimming, Dance, Golf, Bowling, Volunteering, and so many more.

In 2022, FRIENDS offered a menu of fun community activities to 78 of our participants through our four Social Events held each month through our Social Program. At these events our Friends enjoyed going to sporting events, our annual BBQ, holiday parties, volunteer opportunities, games with friends, pampering at the salon, and so much more. These Social Events are a time for our participants to build upon their friendships and our community.

134 of our participants were also able to travel across Colorado and the United States in 2022 through our Travel Program. They visited many places like Disney World, Las Vegas, Chicago, Glenwood Springs, Hawaii and so many other amazing destinations. For many participants, this is the first time taking a vacation without their caregivers. They are experiencing exciting destinations with their peers, and doing activities they never thought possible, like skiing, camping, boating, and horseback riding.

# Supported Employment Program



Work is an important part of life. The benefits from work include financial independence and security, increased self-confidence, personal growth, skill development, and a more fulfilling social life.

FRIENDS uses a person-centered career planning model that takes into account personal preferences, strengths, goals and dreams. To ensure that participants are going to be successful in a position, FRIENDS provides support to the individual throughout the entire process, providing support with job development, job searching, the interview process, and on the job training and support.

*Morighann has always had a love of animals. However, because of her physical disabilities she never thought she could actually get her dream job. She was wrong and Supported Employment staff at FRIENDS helped her get a job at City Bark working with Solo dogs. Two afternoons a week Morighann works with dogs that don't like other dogs but like people. She is now called "The Dog Whisperer" because of her love and skills in working with dogs. She comes home from her job tired and happy!!*

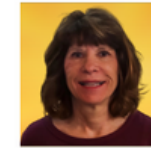

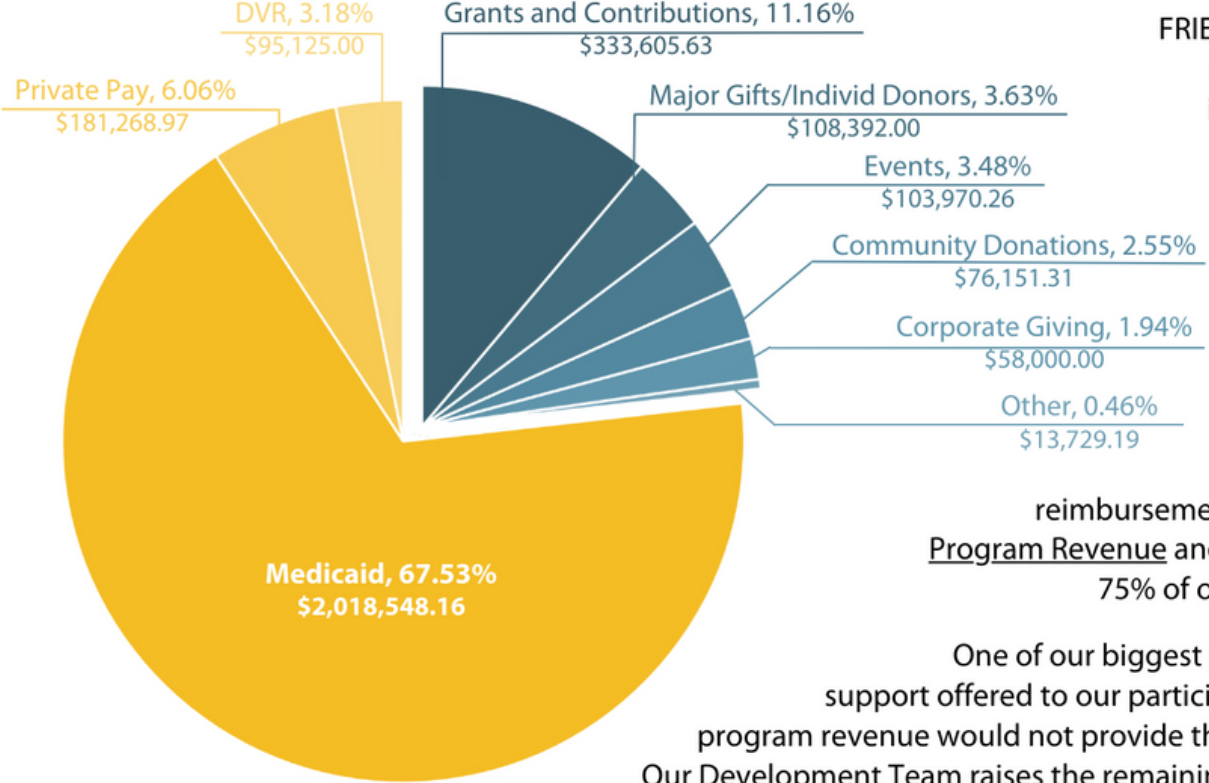

# STRATEGIC PLAN

In 2022, great strides were made in addressing the strategic goals set for FRIENDS for the next three to five years.



FRIENDS is a community-based nonprofit organization that is primarily funded through our participant's individual **Medicaid Home and Community Based Service Waivers** that provide approximately 70% of our revenue. These **Medicaid Waivers** combined with **Participant Pay** and reimbursements from **DVR**, made up our **Program Revenue** and accounted for a little over 75% of our overall revenue in 2022.

One of our biggest priorities is the level of staff support offered to our participants. Solely relying on our program revenue would not provide the funds to accomplish this. Our Development Team raises the remaining 25% through **Grants and Contributions, Major Gifts/Individual Donors, Events, Community Donations, Corporate Giving, and other fundraising methods** to ensure funds necessary to provide the highest level of support through our services.

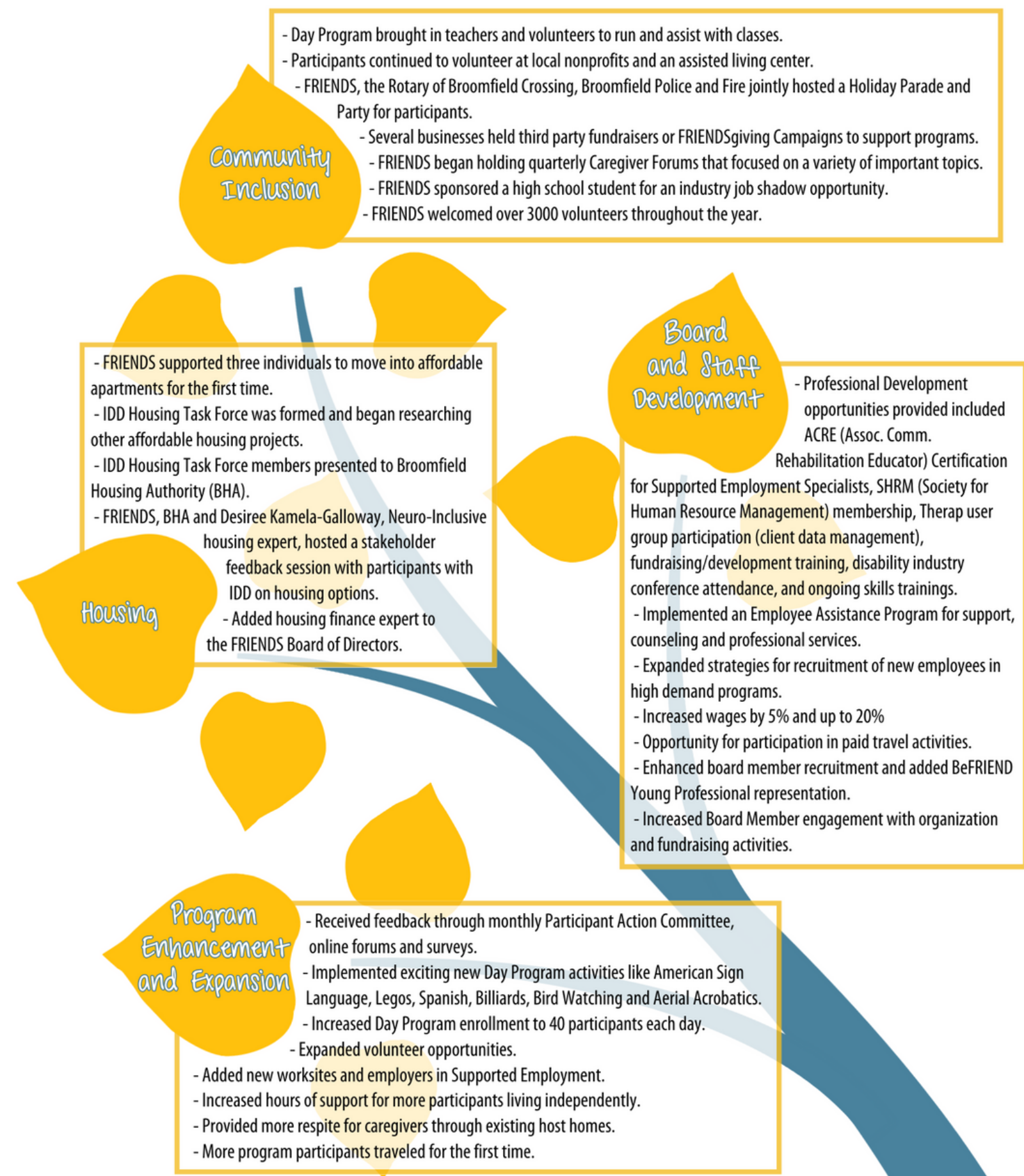
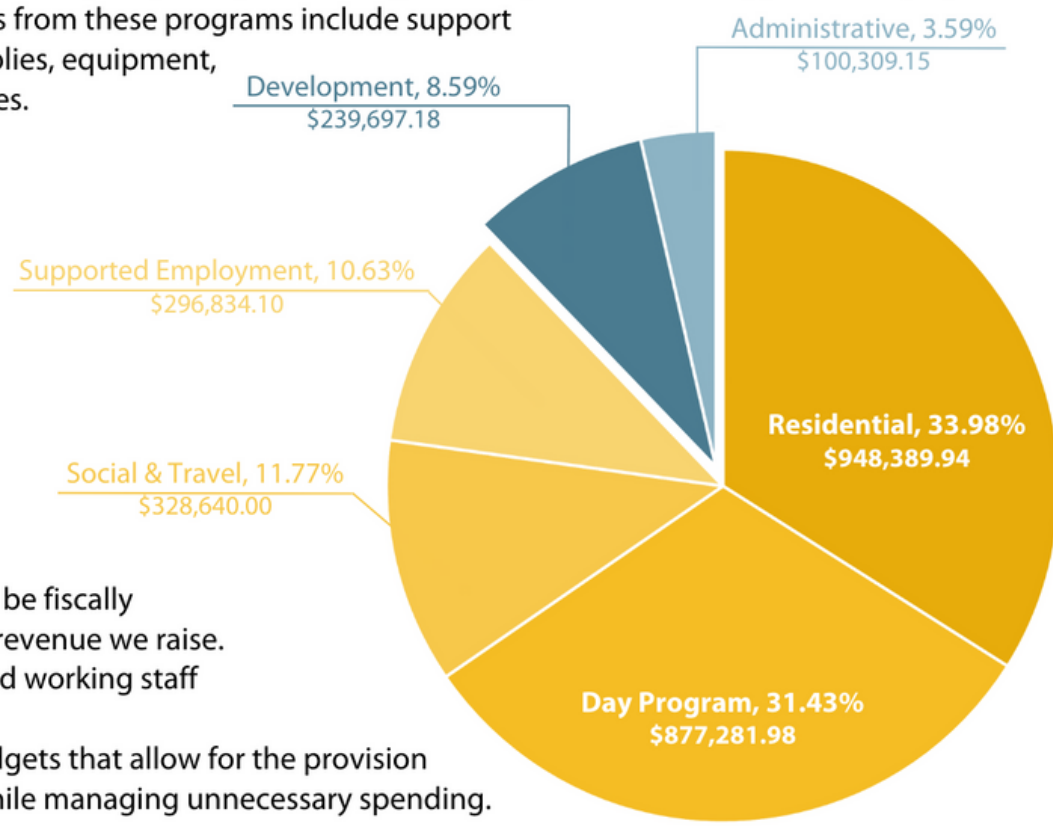
FRIENDS services offer choice and opportunity for participants through our **Day, Residential, Supported Employment, and Social & Travel** Programs. Expenses from these programs include support for our participants, activity costs, supplies, equipment, facility costs, and transportation services. In 2022, 88% of our expenses were allocated to **Program Expense**.

The remaining 12% of our expenses in 2022 were allocated to **Development Expenses** and **Administrative Expenses**.

In 2022, our **Net Ordinary Income** was \$197,768.26 and our **Assets & Liabilities** totaled \$4.5 million.

It is the goal of FRIENDS' Leadership to be fiscally responsible and good stewards of the revenue we raise. We are dedicated to rewarding our hard working staff through raises and benefits. We work hard to develop program budgets that allow for the provision of unique and exciting experiences, while managing unnecessary spending. We undergo annual financial audits.

FRIEND Board and staff are dedicated to ensuring the organization is prepared for long term sustainability through diversified investment of available funds under the guidance of a reputable advisor.
