

## Do you love to Travel?


Independent Contractors assist FRIENDS of Broomfield with transportation, social and community interactions, finances, medication administration, self-care, superision during activities, and other duties as needed.

FRIENDS of Broomfield is looking for Independent Contractors to accompany adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities on their vacations and provide the care and supports they need to enhance their travel experience.

FRIENDS of Broomfield has over 20 trips schedules annually and we fill each trip with tours, activities, and unique things to do in every location. We offer three levels of participation:

- Day trips: local community cased outings
- Enhanced weekend trips: 1-4 day and overnight trips in Colorado
- Extended Trips: 5-9 day trips throughout the United States





In addition to a daily stipend, Independent Contractors' travel expenses are also covered, including airline transportation, food and lodging, and all activity costs.

Independent Contractors qualifications include:

Experience working with individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities, FRIENDS of Broomfield will provide training.

- Valid driver's license
- CPR and Frist Aid certification
- QMAP certification
- Must be able to lift, pull and push up to 50 pounds
