Because a Habitat mortgage is often more affordable than rent, many homebuyers further their education, start businesses, or grow their families, changing their lives for generations to come.

What is Unity Build?

Unity Build is a collaboration of local faith groups facilitated by New Orleans Area Habitat for Humanity. People of all faiths unite to build a home for a hard-working New Orleans family. Through shared work, new friendships are formed, and we learn that more unites us than divides us. Through this collaboration, we will build a new affordable home for a hardworking New Orleans family.

Who can participate in Unity Build?

New Orleans Habitat has invited dozens of local congregations to participate. Unity Build will bring together a variety of faith groups from across New Orleans; people of different traditions, neighborhoods, and experiences will work side by side with a hard-working New Orleans family, who will purchase the house. The project is open to all, and we welcome your suggestions for additional groups to invite.

Why should we participate?

Even though we come from different traditions, we are all children of God. We believe that it is very important that people of all faiths in this city demonstrate their unity through common service, and we believe building a home is a perfect way to do so. Through laying a strong foundation - spiritual and physical - we can play an integral role in building hope in the city of New Orleans.



How can we get involved?

There are many ways to get involved! Along with financial support, all groups will be invited to participate in building on-site by providing volunteers and hospitality. Whether you can swing a hammer, wield a paintbrush, serve lunch, or bake a batch of cookies, your help will be valuable in the process. Pledges can be any size - \$1,500 to \$10,000 - or more! Pledges can be made now and will be due by June 30, 2023.

Women Build is an annual event that recruits and empowers women of all different ages, backgrounds, and industries. Local women come together to build homes and make a powerful and visible impact on our community through housing and neighborhood revitalization efforts. Women Build is a truly unique and exciting opportunity for women in our community, no matter what their skill levels, to roll up their sleeves to promote positive, women-led impact. Projects include the option to participate on new home build or home repair projects. Lunch, water, and snacks provided for your volunteers on build days.

The build environment will allow women of all capabilities and backgrounds to come together in support of one another and the Habitat Partner Family. Volunteers will include women from all walks of life to contribute their time, talent, and labor to the project.
