THE SOUND OF HOPE: REACHING LIVES THROUGH RADIO

Radio continues to shape societies, amplify voices, and connect communities. Despite evolving technology, it remains one of the most accessible and effective ways to share information, encouragement, and hope, especially where geography, poverty, conflict, or persecution limit access to other resources.

For more than 50 years, TWR Canada has used radio to cross physical borders and cultural divides, helping people hear God's Word in their own language. As part of this global media ministry, TWR Canada is grateful to partner with stations broadcasting the gospel in many regions of the world.

TWR Canada partners with stations such as The National Radio & Television of Burundi, Apetina and Tepu Station in Suriname, Kakuma Station in Kenya, Santiago FM 100.1 Tower in Bolivia, Eswats Station in Eswatini, and FM 94.3 and FM 94.5 in Sri Lanka to share life-changing biblical content with listeners. For over 60 years, TWR has also broadcast Spanish programming into Cuba from the transmitter on Bonaire, and since 2009 TWR Canada has supported this ministry through funding for *Messages of Hope and Faith and Our Praise and Worship*.

Through these partnerships, people in more than 190 countries and territories have access to programming in over 200 languages and dialects. Across every frequency and community represented, lives are being impacted by the message of the gospel. In places where churches face persecution and believers remain isolated, media creates opportunities for people to encounter biblical teaching, grow in their faith, and find encouragement.

WEEK 1 RADIO MINISTRY

- 1 Thank You, Lord, for the gift of radio and media, and for the many ways You continue to use these tools to bring the hope of Christ to people across borders, languages, and cultures.
- 2 Lord, we pray for the Eswats Station in Eswatini, known as "the pulpit of Africa," as it continues to broadcast across East and Southern Africa in more than 30 languages through AM and shortwave radio.

- 3+4 Pray for TWR Burundi, including the *Good News For All* broadcast. Lord, use these programs to bring grace, reconciliation, and hope to listeners across Burundi and neighbouring regions.
- 5+6 Pray for the ongoing reach of the Santiago FM 100.1 signal in Bolivia, that it would continue extending into communities across the Tucavaca Valley, including Serranías de Santiago and Chochís.
- 7 Lord we pray that You would sustain the transmitters at the Apetina and Tepu radio stations in Suriname and keep every signal strong and clear.
- 8 Pray for the SIFA FM network upgrades in Kenya, across Kakuma, Lodwar, Voi, Lamu, Marsabit, and Loyangalani.
- 9 Pray for *God's Unique Book* broadcasts on FM 94.3 and 94.5 in Sri Lanka. We ask that You continue to use these programs to reach the hearts of listeners, especially within the Sinhala Buddhist community.
- 10 Pray for TWR Canada's ministry in Cuba, that God would continue to sustain and expand the reach of radio broadcasts from Bonaire and digital programs like *Messages of Hope and Faith and Our Praise and Worship*.

FROM DEVICE TO DISCIPLESHIP: MEDIA PLAYERS IN THE GLOBAL MINISTRY

In 2026, TWR Canada is helping spread the message of hope through radio, media players, and radio home groups across 21 nations. These tools create opportunities for people to encounter the gospel, grow in their faith, and engage with God's Word in their own language.

Media players remain a key part of this ministry. For more than a decade, TWR Canada has helped distribute them through global partnerships, **with support given to see over 1,300 devices sent to more than 11 countries in 2025 alone.** Loaded with Bibles, biblical teaching, and other resources in local languages, these portable devices bring God's Word directly into communities, including places where literacy or access to Christian resources may be limited.

Because many regions have limited internet access and inconsistent electricity, media players provide a reliable way for people to access God's Word offline. All devices can be charged via USB, while solar-powered units offer added flexibility in remote areas by allowing charging through sunlight. With biblical content fully stored on each device, media players also help reach communities with little access to Christian radio or internet services, ensuring people can still hear the gospel regardless of infrastructure.

At TWR Canada, we often hear stories of how, when TWR radio content is playing, people begin to move closer and gravitate toward the sound of Scripture. Listeners engage with Bible stories being shared, often pausing their work or gathering nearby to listen more closely, reflecting more deeply on God's Word.

A pastor in Tanzania shared: *"We are thankful for Global Aid Network, Tanzania, for the provision of the Trans World Radio (TWR) Canada media players because it has become our tool to connect with many people indirectly by approaching them with a narrated story from the Bible. Access to the materials available on the players has helped plant two churches and see many find hope in Christ."*

WEEK 2 MEDIA PLAYERS

"Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation."

11+12 Pray for individuals and families receiving media players in communities around the world, that they would encounter God's Word in a personal and life-changing way.

13 Pray for those hearing the gospel for the first time through radio broadcasts, media players, and radio home groups, that their hearts would be open to the message of hope in Christ.

14 Pray for the media players being distributed in 2026. Lord, we ask for safe delivery, smooth logistics, and that each device would become a powerful tool for gospel access in the hands of those who receive it.

15 Pray for TWR Canada's on-the-ground ministry partners who help facilitate distribution and engagement. Pray for unity and strength as they serve in diverse and often challenging contexts.

16 Pray for the TWR Canada team responsible for managing orders and inventory. Pray for wisdom, accuracy, and diligence as they track resources, coordinate shipments, and ensure media players are prepared and delivered efficiently.

17+18 Pray for those involved in the production of media players. Pray for smooth manufacturing processes, reliable supply chains, and excellence at every stage of assembly.

19+20 Pray for God's provision and continued guidance over this ministry, that every media player distributed would serve as more than a device—but as a doorway for people to access the gospel and be discipled.



EQUIPPING LEADERS AND STRENGTHENING THE CHURCH THROUGH TRAINING

TWR Canada supports ongoing biblical training, discipleship, and leadership development in restricted and hard-to-reach regions of the world to strengthen the global Church. Below are two key examples of training ministries we support in different parts of the world.



In China, TWR Canada has supported ministry for more than 30 years. **Through the Seminary on the Air (SOTA) program, pastors and church leaders receive theological education in Mandarin through secure and accessible formats designed for restricted environments.** Since 2011, the SOTA curriculum has equipped more than 1,800 graduates and is currently serving over 2,750 students, with many now leading and strengthening churches across mainland China and the global Chinese community.

In Iran and the wider Persian-speaking world, access to Christian resources remains highly limited and often carries significant personal risk. Christian converts and house church leaders frequently face intense pressure because of their faith. **For more than 40 years, TWR Canada has ministered to Iranians in Iran and across the Persian-speaking world through radio, digital media, and in-person ministry.** What began as radio broadcasting grew into gatherings where Iranians could safely hear the gospel, receive discipleship, and return strengthened in their faith. **Today, the ministry continues with the growth of digital radio, social platforms, and personal follow-up with seekers and believers.**

TWR Canada continues to provide trusted theological training and discipleship resources that strengthen believers, equip leaders, and support the growth of the Church in challenging environments.

WEEK 3 TRAINING

-  **21** Pray for pastors, church leaders, and students currently involved in the *Seminary on the Air (SOTA)* program in China. Lord, strengthen them spiritually as they receive theological training and apply it in their ministries and churches.
-  **22** Pray for the continued growth and impact of the SOTA curriculum, that more leaders would be equipped, discipled, and prepared to faithfully teach God's Word across mainland China and the global Chinese community.
-  **23** Pray for believers and seekers in Iran and the wider Persian-speaking world who are engaging with the gospel through radio, digital media, and discipleship outreach.
-  **24+25** Pray for those in Iran who are part of house churches and informal gatherings, that they would be encouraged, protected, and grounded in sound biblical teaching as they grow in Christ.
-  **26+27** Pray for the *Discipleship Essentials (DE)* training partnership in the Philippines through CAMACOP. Ask God to strengthen pastors, leaders, and believers as they are equipped to lead small groups and disciple others.
-  **28** Pray for the *Tools for Wise Leadership* training and broadcast project in Sudan and South Sudan. Lord, use the Juba Arabic translation, radio broadcasts, and leadership training to equip leaders at all levels with biblical wisdom and integrity.
-  **29** Pray for our TWR Canada team as we hire for several new positions within our ministry. Ask God to guide us to the right people and equip and train them to serve faithfully and effectively in these roles.
-  **30** Pray for new ministry partnerships to support and expand training and discipleship efforts in more regions around the world.

GATHERING AROUND GOD'S WORD: RADIO HOME GROUPS IN SRI LANKA

Across Sri Lanka, TWR Canada—through its partnership with TWR Asia—supports Radio Home Groups as a practical way for people to gather around God's Word. Through traditional radio, digital tools, and media players, the gospel is reaching people who may otherwise never hear it. When people cannot safely gather, read, or access Christian resources, media helps bring God's Word directly into homes and communities.



Radio programs can be listened to privately, at work, or within the home, making them especially valuable for those who cannot regularly attend church or who face social or family constraints. Many listeners in Sri Lanka come from Buddhist and Hindu backgrounds and often live in places where Christianity may be misunderstood or where access to a local church is limited.

Radio Home Groups are one-way TWR Canada partners with churches in Sri Lanka to provide biblical teaching and discipleship. Groups of people meet regularly to listen to a message, discuss it together, study Scripture, and share in fellowship. Through this self-study Bible program, participants receive theological and discipleship training while also learning how to share the gospel with others.

Through this partnership, more than 1,000 Radio Home Groups are able to meet, learn, and grow in faith. Listeners are using these media resources to strengthen their faith and disciple others, often laying the foundation for new Christian communities across the country.

One Sri Lankan Radio Home Group attendee shared, *"Within minutes, God took all of my burdens and I was set free. I have benefitted greatly from the TWR Radio Home Group."*

-  **11** Pray for the more than 1,000 Radio Home Groups in Sri Lanka, that they would remain strong places of fellowship, Bible study, and encouragement.
-  **12** Pray for group leaders and facilitators as they guide discussions and help others understand Scripture. Ask God to give them wisdom, clarity, and spiritual strength.
-  **13** Pray for those hearing God's Word through radio broadcasts and media tools, especially individuals engaging with the gospel for the first time.
-  **14+15** Pray for people from Buddhist and Hindu backgrounds who are exploring Christianity. God we ask you reveal yourself to them personally and lead them into a relationship with You.
-  **16+17** Pray for those who are unable to attend church due to social, family, or cultural pressures. Pray that Radio Home Groups and media resources would provide consistent spiritual support and encouragement.
-  **18** Pray that participants in Radio Home Groups would grow in their understanding of Scripture and be equipped to share their faith and disciple others within their own communities.
-  **19** Pray for the people of Sri Lanka — that more individuals would come to know Christ and commit their lives to Jesus. Pray that they would be nurtured in faith, grow spiritually, and become true disciples who live according to God's Word.
-  **20** Pray for the current economic situation in Sri Lanka. Ask God to provide for families facing hardship, bring stability in uncertain times, and strengthen communities experiencing financial pressure and need.

ALBERTA MINISTRY IMPACT TOUR 2026 RECAP

This past spring, TWR Canada hosted our Alberta Ministry Impact Tour, gathering with 531 people across the province from April 26–May 3 for dinners, dessert evenings, church services, and special screenings of the *Lifted* documentary. Across seven tour stops, guests heard powerful stories of lives being transformed through our media ministry around the world.

Throughout the tour, attendees also learned more about TWR Canada's global impact, including our work in Cuba, Sri Lanka, Iran, and China, highlighting how media continues to share the hope of the gospel in some of the world's most hard-to-reach places.

We are deeply grateful for the generosity of our supporters. Because of our donors, churches, and corporate sponsors (Christian Credit Union, Shine 88.9 FM, Okotoks Evangelical Free Church, and Creekside Home and Garden) the 2026 Ministry Impact Tour raised more than **\$70,000** in support of the life-changing work of TWR Canada.
